## CRAWFORD COUNTY ARKANSAS

### QUORUM COURT JOURNAL OF PROCEEDINGS

The Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas met June 1, 2019, for the second special meeting of the year. The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. at the Emergency Management Building at 1820 Chestnut, Van Buren, Arkansas. Crawford County Judge Gilstrap presiding. Those present were Sheriff Ron Brown, Brad Thomas emergency management director, two Corp of Engineer Mr. Ellis and Mr. Howard, four Quorum Court members, Superintendent of Mt. Burg School Mrs. Debbie Atwell, Chris Keith County Road Superintendent and a representative from the Southwest Times Record.

#### BRIEFING ON THE CRAWFORD COUNTY FLOODING

Main purpose of this meeting is to let you know what is going on and I know you want to help. We have been busy addressing the concerns of our 22 mile of levee that is being stressed at historical levels. Last report was 5600 feet per second down the river. The river has reached 40.79 crest. It has started to decrease but our concerns have not, about 32 feet we can relax a little that the water is not touching the levee. Then we are going to have to think about how to get the levee to protect the next time in the same area.

We have been spending money from the Crawford County budget to purchase needed items to work with during the flood. The Governor has sent support from the state letting the National Guard come in with helicopters to help move the materials on a certain spot of concern located in the Yoestown bottoms. We covered the levee over in this area and we had some rain right after that and the plastic did what it was supposed to do to help this area in Yoestown from getting saturated.

The thing with the levee is meant to hold the water off the protected area for a short period of time. The more velocity and height and duration of the water sitting on the levee is stressing the levee more and more.

There has been some issues with sand boils. When I called the sheriff there was not one hesitation to help. Sheriff Brown said he would have 30 inmates and it was like 30 minutes he had them there helping to fill sand bags. They worked 4 days and they worked hard.

I got the figures from unappropriated funds, county general \$110,861.75, and public safety \$66,896.31 and county highway money. We will probably have to move some money around and take care of this. The President has already declared Arkansas as a disaster emergency.

Mrs. Debbie Atwell, Superintendent of Mt. Burg School questioned how many homes this evacuation at Yoestown would consist of, Sheriff Brown stated there was a total of 152 and joining with Van Buren there was a total of 330 of names and emergency contacts.

The Forrest Service started monitoring 24/7 on the levee.

There was actually two days we pulled all road equipment and crews out from the highway department to help. Chris Keith stated they moved about 300 tons of material onto a farmers farm land. We used county equipment to move the bags once we filled them and moved them out to where the helicopter could access them, we have not seen numbers on it and at that time it didn't matter.

These levees were built back in the 40's. There is roughly 23 million dollars a day that was projected that go up and down the river.

The issue we have in this area is that these farms are the lowest point in elevation.

The lead on this flooding has pretty much been the sheriff's department in the organization. This has been a very difficult incident to plan for and Captain Patti Stroud of the sheriff's department has been the one behind the planning.

I commend the Sheriff's Department, Highway Department and Emergency Management Department for all of them working together.

The documentation of this disaster will be used in the future. We have got to get the levee prepared to handle another situation like this in the future.

### QUORUM COURT JOURNAL OF PROCEEDINGS

The Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas met June 17, 2019, for the sixth regular meeting of the year. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Circuit Courtroom #2, 220 South 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Van Buren, Arkansas. Crawford County Judge Gilstrap presiding. Jacob Howell, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, legal counselor was present. Roll was called. Members present were Justices Roger Atwell, Lloyd Cole, Cox, Decroo, Damante, Harvey, Johnson, Myers, Peppas, Perry, Shaffer, Wahlmeier and Woodruff.

The minutes of the last regular meeting and reports were presented. Justice Woodruff moved to approve, second by Justice Peppas and unanimous voice vote the minutes were approved as written.

The minutes of the Budget Committee meetings, Justice Perry made the motion to approve, second by Justice Decroo and unanimous voice vote the minutes were approved.

#### COMMITTEE REPORTS:

JUDGES NOTE: (1) Judge Gilstrap made the acknowledgment that Jim Preston and Jim White, which represents the Quorum Court on the Board of Equalization, their term is up this July, 2019 so we need to vote on continuing them to represent the Quorum Court if in agreement. Motion by Justice Myers, second by Justice Damante to approve the reappointment of these two men to the Crawford County Equalization Board, unanimous voice vote taken. (2) Flooding has been an issue which we have been dealing with lately. Thanks to the Sheriff's Office, Highway Department, Emergency Management Department, Corp of Engineers and the State Forrest Service for their timeless hours that they have put in during this flooding. I think people are going to look at that large green hump that runs down our bottoms in a different light then they have previously done in the past. We have worked with all the cities up and down the river and I am pleased that the levee did not breach, there was a lot of concern of this breach. There is 22 miles of levee with 4 miles being in the city of Van Buren in which it is under their levee board then there is 18 miles under the Levee District #1 Board which runs all the way to Clear Creek. It takes both the city and county to keep this levee maintained to work appropriately. Those levees are to protect the areas that will flood. The Corp of Engineer is now in here doing an assessment of our levee. If they identify any places that was damage by the flood it is my understanding is they will cover the cost of rehabilitating it back to where it should be and also they will identify any weak spots. Also we have learned a lot about Sand Boils during this experience. When they closed the three bridges they were looking at the approach and relief bridges and the also the water had risen to a point to where it was starting to hit the beams under the bridges. The levees having been maintained and certified over the years that's why they are back in here. (3) We had a couple of blow outs on Old 81 Loop and Parks road due to the heavy down pours of rain, we have made emergency repairs on both. Back in 2009 the levee was recertified under the former County Judge John Hall. (4) Justice Cole questioned where we stood on the Jail Bond money. Judge Gilstrap stated he should have the figures in August. What I am looking forward to giving you is when the bond will be paid off. (5) Division III is down to being

painted and they will be putting down carpet. July 1, 2019 is the goal and opening date of our new Division III Court. (6) Lightening issues, we are still gathering estimates which somewhere is around \$150,000.00 to \$160,000.00. Part of the holdup has been with the IT. (7) Paving has slowed down due to rain and flooding.

On motion by Justice Johnson, second by Justice Cole Resolution No. 2019-5 was presented. There was much discussion, Justice Wahlmeier moved to table, second by Justice Atwell. Show of hands **to table** and to publicize in the Press Argus Courier and take applications for two weeks, 9 yeas and 4 nays.

Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas an ordinance to be entitled:

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CRAWFORD COUNTY JUDGE TO ENTER INTO A FINANCING AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF FOUR (4) TRI-AXLE DUMP TRUCKS AND:**

WHEREAS, Crawford County has previously solicited bids for the purchase of 4 tri-axle dump trucks; and

WHEREAS, the bid was awarded to the company that met the specifications for the bid and said bid calling for financing of \$596,400.00 with \$161,000.00 trade in allowed down and \$145,133.00 due in twelve months and \$145,133.00 due in 24 months and the balance of \$145,134.00 plus interest due with thirty-six months; and

WHEREAS, Crawford County has previously solicited proposals for obtaining financing for \$ 435,400.00 for said purchases; and Citizen's Bank and Trust, Van Buren, Arkansas has submitted the bid with interest of 3.35% or less and;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD COUNTY:

SECTION 1. That all statutory provisions of law concerning the awarding of bids for the purchase of equipment by Crawford County and all statutory provisions of law concerning the solicitation of proposals for financing have been followed.

SECTION 2. The County Judge of Crawford County is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Financing Agreement for obtaining funds to be used for the purchase of four tri-axle dump trucks and Financing Agreement not to exceed \$ 435,400.00 plus interest.

SECTION 3.
