## CRAWFORD COUNTY ARKANSAS

### QUORUM COURT JOURNAL OF PROCEEDINGS

The Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas met October 21, 2019, for the tenth regular meeting of the year. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Circuit Courtroom #2, 220 South 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Van Buren, Arkansas. Judge Gilstrap presiding. Jacob Howell, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, legal counselor was present. Roll was called. Members present were Justices Atwell, Cole, Cox, DeCroo, Damante, Harvey, Johnson, Myers, Peppas Perry, Shaffer, and Woodruff. Justice Wahlmeier was absent

The minutes of the last Regular September meeting and reports were presented. Justice Woodruff moved to approve and second by Justice Peppas and unanimous voice vote the minutes and reports were approved as written.

The minutes of the budget committee were presented. Justice Harvey moved to approve, second by Justice Atwell. Unanimous voice vote minutes and reports were approved as written.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: (1) Justice Harvey spoke briefly on the ACT Work Ready program which is about 65% complete. There is about 70 business's on board for our Career Rodeo coming up in Mulberry in May of 2020. We have all schools on board with this program. This career rodeo will consist of electrical, plumbing, builders, truck drivers and etc. This is to show the students the possibilities available out in the workforce. Judge Gilstrap wanted to thank Justice Harvey for his participation with this program and that he would be attending the ACT Work Ready Conference coming up and that WAPDD is paying \$500.00 of the \$1,500.00 fee, in which the county will pay the difference

JUDGES NOTE: (1) Judge Gilstrap stated that the road department has started on Old 12 Crossroad, which will be blocked off for three to four weeks. This is to replace a 6 foot culvert which is quite a project since it is so deep down. Also highway department has started on Old Rowe Road, which we have ½ of the clearing done. (2) Crawford County received a \$40,000.00 grant from the National Recreational Parks Association for a 10 minute hiking/walking trail. (3) On October 18, 2019 Crawford County will be 199 years old. Elaine Stanfield is trying to put together a 200<sup>th</sup> celebration for next year in October 2020. (4) 911 Board has been meeting with APCO (Association Public Safety Community Officials), in which they came in to do a basic assessment of our 911 dispatchers. This is to see how we are going to come up with a consolidation of our three existing 911, Van Buren Police, Alma Police and Crawford County Sheriff. To receive any 911 funding we will have to be certified by the State 911 Board. (5) Herb Ginn with the Crawford County Extension Office wanted to thank the Quorum Court for their participation in the 4-H program, also he introduced several members of the extension office along with a farmer Randy Arnold that works close with the extension office along with the 4-H members. Randy Arnold spoke on how he depends on the extension office for several things and how he enjoys the elementary schools bringing their students out for 'Fun on the Farm Days' to see how they grow produce along with the farm animals for them to pet.

On motion by Justice Peppas, second by Justice Damante, Ordinance No. 2019-28 was presented as amended. After reading in its entirety, Justice Damante moved to approve, second by Justice Perry. There was some discussion by the court, roll call vote 12 yeas, 1 absent.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC: (1) Elaine Stanfield wished to thank everyone for helping with the county wide trash pick-up. There was 72,950 pounds of trash collected, with Natural Dam the winner of the most collected, which was 12,000 pounds. Don't forget the upcoming census for 2020, please do participate in their questions, this will help the county in funding. (2) Sharon Blount-Baker, Circuit Clerk announced that she has received the grant for \$13,192.00 to scan and index things in the office.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: Justice Peppas announced that he would be proposing a couple of things in the next couple of meetings, which one would be a 'county noise ordinance' and another would be a 'millage increase' on the county's part which now is 2.9 mill I would like to change it by .6 mill with a total of 3.5 mill. If there is no agreement on the millage increase for the county then they would have to start thinking of laying off employees or cut services. (2) Eric Simpson, Rural Fire Department Coordinator passed out a pamphlet with information on the Rural Fire Department. Legal counsel Jacob Howell address the Quorum Court and the Rural Fire Department on how this could be handled with several different oppositions for the Rural Fire Department to have their dues collected on their county tax statements.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE LEVYING 2019 COUNTY TAXES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated 14-14-904(b)(1), other related acts and the Constitution of the State of Arkansas, the following Crawford County taxes are hereby levied:

SECTION 2. County General taxes for general county purposes, 2.9 mills.

SECTION 3. County Road taxes for road purposes, 3.0 mills.

SECTION 4. County Library taxes for library purposes, 1.4 mills.

SECTION 5. Each of the above millage rates shall be upon each dollar of assessed valuation of all real and personal property subject to taxation within Crawford County, Arkansas.

SECTION 6. This being an Appropriation Ordinance, approved by not less than two-thirds of the whole number of Justices comprising this court, it shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its approval by the County Judge.

**AN ORDINANCE LEVYING (RENEWING) THE MILLAGE TAX FOR THE CITY GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES AND FOR THE PUBLIC LIBRARY PURPOSES FOR THE YEAR 2019; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the City of Van Buren, Arkansas, is duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Arkansas, with all powers, authority and duties of a city of the First Class; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Ordinance is immediately necessary for preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Van Buren, Arkansas, and an emergency exists which requires that this Ordinance become immediately effective and in full force and effect; and

WHEREAS, the City of Van Buren, Arkansas, must have funds for its municipal operations, and can only obtain the requisite funding to continue its current level of services to its citizens by renewing the levy of a 2 mill tax on real and personal property, for the general municipal purpose of the City, and by renewing the levy of a 1.4 mill tax on real and personal property tax for the Van Buren library maintenance purposes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VAN BUREN, ARKANSAS, THAT:**

SECTION 1: The rate of all real and personal property taxes in Van Buren, Arkansas, for the year 2019, for general municipal purposes under the authority of Section 4, Article XII, of the Constitution of 1874, of the State of Arkansas, be, and the same is hereby affixed at 2 mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of all real and personal property subject to taxation in the City of Van Buren, Arkansas, for the year 2019, for general municipal purposes.


SECTION 2: The rate of all real and personal property taxes in the City of Van Buren, Arkansas, for the year of 2019, for the maintenance of a City Public Library, under the authority of a vote of the people of the City of Van Buren, Arkansas, and the City General Elections held on the 7th day of April, 1942, (1 mill) and the 8th day of November, 1994, (.4 mill), be, and the same is hereby affixed at 1.4 mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of all real and personal property subject to taxation in the City of Van Buren, Arkansas, for the year 2019, for the library maintenance purposes,

subject to the provisions of Act No. 848 of 1981; the same being "adjustment or rollback of tax rates due to increase in aggregate valuation of taxable property."


**SECTION 3:** A Certified Copy of this Ordinance shall be filed in the office of the County Clerk of Crawford County, Arkansas, in order that the Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas, may include the same in the general levy of the year 2019 and cause the same to be extended upon the tax books and collected as required by law.

**SECTION 4:** This Ordinance being immediately necessary to obtain revenue to pay expenses of the City Government for the City of Van Buren, Arkansas, and necessary in providing for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be, take effect, and be in force after its passage and publication.


