QUORUM COURT JOURNAL OF PROCEEDINGS

The Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas met November 18, 2019, for the eleventh regular meeting of the year. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Circuit Courtroom #2, 220 South 4th Street, Van Buren, Arkansas. Crawford County Judge Gilstrap presiding. Jacob Howell, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, legal counselor was present. Roll was called. Members present were Justices Cole, Cox, DeCroy, Damante, Harvey, Johnson, Myers, Peppas, Perry, Shaffer, Wahlmeier, Woodruff with Justice Atwell absent

The minutes of the last regular meeting and reports were presented. Justice Harvey moved to approve and second by Justice Woodruff and unanimous voice vote the minutes and reports were approved as written.

The minutes of the budget committee meetings, Justice Harvey made the motion to approve, second by Justice Perry were presented and approved as written.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: (1) Justice Harvey, stated that he went to a summit for the ACT Work Ready Program in which city, county leaders were there along with public educators from all across the country. I am going to ask Dennis Williamson to the December or January meeting to give us an update on how this is moving along for 2020. (2) Port: past couple of weeks there has been quite a bit of movement. WAIPA (Western Arkansas Intermodal Port Authority) has reached out to Judge Gilstrap because they are going after an EDA grant for \$450,000.00, it will be an 80/20 grant. This is for funding the engineering of the utilities and any fees we might have for environmental study that is needed to continue moving this project forward. City of Van Buren has stepped up and wants to be a part of this, as far as Sebastian County and the City of Fort Smith I am not aware of their standing on this project.

JUDGES NOTE: (1) Judge Gilstrap stated that the highway department has lost about a week worth of work on Old #12 road, but we are now filling it back up, still on schedule other than the rain. (2) We have started in on our next lease agreement on our graders and we have now just received the four new dump trucks, which were supposed to be delivered by mid – September. (3) Jacob Howell, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, legal counselor addressed the Quorum Court about a lawsuit (Rural Fire Departments Taxation) that has been filed today against County Judge Gilstrap and the Quorum Court as an institution. I have begun drafting an answer to their attorney. We will report back to you next month. You as a Quorum need not worry about hiring counsel, we have it under control.



ORDINANCE 2019-35**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD COUNTY,
ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE SETTING NOISE RESTRICTIONS.

SECTION 1.

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person to make, continue, or cause to be made or continued, any loud, unnecessary, or unusual noise or any noise which either annoys, disturbs, injures, or endangers the comfort, repose, health peace, or safety of others, within the limits of the Crawford County.
- B. The following acts, among others, are declared to be loud, disturbing, and unnecessary noises in violation of this ordinance, but said enumeration shall not be deemed to be exclusive namely:
 - 1. Horns, etc. The sounding of any horn or device on any automobile, motorcycle, bus or other vehicles while not in motion, except as a danger signal; the creation by means of any such signaling device of any unreasonable period of time that disturbs the quiet or comfort of any person in the vicinity.
 - 2. Radios, musical instruments, etc. The playing of any radio or musical instrument or other musical device for producing or reproducing of sound, in such a manner or with such volume, particularly during the hours between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. as to disturb the quiet or comfort of persons in any office, hospital or in any dwelling, hotel or other type of residence or of any persons in the vicinity. The operation of any such instrument, machine or device between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. in such a manner as to be plainly audible at a distance of fifty (50) ft. from the building, structure or vehicle in which it is located shall be prima facie evidence of a violation of this ordinance.
 - 3. Singing, shouting, etc. Yelling, shouting, whistling or singing on the public streets, particularly between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. or at any time or place so as to annoy or disturb the quiet or comfort of persons in any office, hospital or in any dwelling, hotel or other types of residence, or of any persons in the vicinity shall be prohibited.
 - 4. Animals and Fowl, etc. The keeping of any animal or fowl which by causing frequent or long-continued noise shall disturb the quiet or comfort of any person in the vicinity.

5. Un-repaired vehicle. The use of any automobile, motorcycle, or other vehicles so out of repair or so loaded as to create loud and unnecessary grating, grinding, rattling, or other noise.
6. Near schools, courts, churches, hospitals, etc. The creating of any excessive and unnecessary noise on any street adjacent to any school, church, court, while the same is in session, or adjacent to any hospital, which unreasonably interferes with the working of sessions thereof.

SECTION 2. Exemptions.

None of the terms or prohibitions shall apply to or be enforced against:

- A. Any vehicle owned and operated by Crawford County, Arkansas, or any City within Crawford County, Arkansas while engaged upon necessary public business.
- B. Excavations or repairs of bridges, streets or highways by or on behalf of Crawford County, Arkansas, or any City within Crawford County, Arkansas, during the nighttime, when the public welfare and convenience renders it impossible to perform such work during the day.
- C. The reasonable use of amplifiers or loudspeakers in the course of public addresses which are noncommercial in character.
- D. Necessary warning signals given by any vehicle.

SECTION 3. Penalty.

Any person, firm and/or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, except as provided for, be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not less than ten dollars (\$10.00), nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each offense.

SECTION 4. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions of the ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision, and to this end, the provisions of the Ordinance are declared to be severable.

"AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE ANNUAL
OPERATING BUDGET FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2020"**

SECTION 1. ANNUAL BUDGET ADOPTED BY REFERENCE

The annual budget for the calendar year 2020 identified as "2020 Annual Budget, Crawford County, Arkansas" is hereby adopted by reference. A copy of said budget shall be filed in the office of the County Clerk and shall be available for inspection and copying by any person during normal office hours.

SECTION 2. EXPENDITURES RESTRICTED TO SPECIFIED FUND

No expenditure of appropriated funds shall be made from any fund other than the fund specified in the ordinance or any amendment thereto.

SECTION 3. TRANSFERS

Any transfers of moneys between the various funds of the county or between the four major categories of expenditures - Personal Services, Supplies, Other Services and Charges, and Capital Outlays - shall be made only with prior approval of the Crawford County Quorum Court. Provided however, all transfers budgeted for the annual budget shall be exempt from the provisions of this section.

SECTION 5. For the purpose of this ordinance and to maintain the fiscal integrity of the County, funding of appropriation contained herein is dependent upon the availability of adequate revenues. The Quorum Court reserves unto itself the right to impose constraints or restrictions upon the expenditure of funds within the measure should the necessity arise.

SECTION 6. Each item appropriated for salaries herein is the annual salary or compensation for the position. Unless otherwise specified in this ordinance, annual salary or compensation is bi-weekly one week after accrual. If payday falls on a holiday, checks will be issued on the last working day of the week. In the event of vacancy for any period of times in any position or positions set out herein provided for such position or positions shall be proportionally reduced.

SECTION 7. Attachments "A", "B", "C", "D", "E", "F", "G", "H" are the detailed budget requests from each requesting party and show in detail by line item, the purpose or use for the funds requested and the amount appropriated. These documents are on file in the County Clerk's office and may be examined by any member of the public.

SECTION 8. The 2020 Anticipated Revenue for all funds is set forth in Attachment "H" which is hereby incorporated by reference.

SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 10. This Ordinance being necessary for the protection and the preservation of the public health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and take effect upon passage and publication.
