## CRAWFORD COUNTY ARKANSAS

### QUORUM COURT JOURNAL OF PROCEEDINGS

The Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas met January 21, 2020, for the Twelveth meeting of the year. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Circuit Courtroom #2, 220 South 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Van Buren, Arkansas. Crawford County Judge Gilstrap presiding. Rinda Baker, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, legal counselor was present. Roll was called. Members present were Justices Roger Atwell, Lloyd Cole, Cox, DeCroo, Damante, Harvey, Johnson, Myers, Peppas, Perry, Shaffer, Wahlmeier and Woodruff.

The minutes of the Amended November regular meeting, December regular meeting and reports were presented. Justice Peppas moved to approve and second by Justice Woodruff and unanimous voice vote the minutes and reports were approved as written.

The minutes of the budget committee meetings, Justice Atwell made the motion to approve, second by Justice Wahlmeier.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: (1) Justice Harvey stated the port was moving along hope to hear something in the next couple of months. (2) ACT Work Force, we have three more counties that want to come aboard with this program. Career Rodeo will be coming up soon. (3) Justice Atwell stated that Wayne Miller of the University of Arkansas said he would be glad to come and talk about budget process. Also Justice Atwell wanted to talk about paying 1 ½ instead of comp time in the next personnel meeting in February.

JUDGES NOTE: (1) Judge Gilstrap wanted to thank Justice Harvey for his time in all of these committee meetings. (2) Road crew work started out rainy for 2020. (3) Comp time is starting out much better. (4) APERMA who carries our building and auto insurance has notified us that they can no longer carry us. We have got with Association of Arkansas Counties about picking us up, but it will cost a few thousand dollars more than what APERMA was, but they have some very good programs. APERMA will handle any cases that they have taken as of now and the attorney Burt Newell that was our county attorney will now be going over to Association of Arkansas Counties. January 31, 2020 is when the transition goes over from APERMA to Association of Arkansas Counties.

(2) ORDINANCE No. 2020-2: BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF CRAWFORD, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED: AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUDGET ORDINANCE NUMBER 2019-37 TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS AND APPROVE ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURES TO THE CRAWFORD COUNTY 2020 BUDGET FOR VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS; TRANSFERS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. On motion by Justice Shaffer, second by Justice Peppas, Ordinance No. 2020-2 was presented. After reading in its entirety, Justice Harvey moved to approve, second by Justice Wahlmeier. There was some discussion by the court, roll call vote 12 yeas and 1 nays.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC: (1) Senator Bob Ballinger District #5 speaking out for his constituency about the Asher Road being washed out again which is located just South East of Mountainburg. Mr. Ballinger is willing to try to help with whatever resources he can to help with this problem. Judge Gilstrap stated he talked to engineers about this because he has multiple bridges that only have one way out and I would accept any solutions that you might have to fix these bridges. Anything that you could help the county with would be greatly appreciated. We are now trying to partner with Franklin County on a bridge that effects both counties, hopefully we can obtain grant money. (2) Katie Buttres of the Rudy area spoke on the party houses that are going on around the county in the rural parts. All they do is party all night long, they leave their music on from 8:00 a.m. till midnight, it is so loud it rattles the windows and the drugs are getting worse. Please make an ordinance or a law to help control this out in the county. Judge Gilstrap stated that Justice Peppas did bring forth an Ordinance concerning the noise control out in the county last month and it was discussed and did not pass. (3) LaDonna Brewer of the Dripping Springs Trail area spoke on the same problem concerning the noise that goes on out in the county. They would like to get some type of Ordinance to help with this out in the county. One of Mrs. Brewer suggestion is that possibly a time limit or curfew would be established for control of the ordinance. (4) Nathan Wilhelm was there to represent the rural fire department and present an Ordinance that he wishes to present to Quorum Court. Judge Gilstrap let him know he could not discuss this due to the fact of this being in litigation. Judge Gilstrap let him go ahead and speak to the quorum describing this ordinance.



ORDINANCE NO. 2020-3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

"AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT; AND FOR AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING QUALIFIED ELECTORS WITHIN FIRE DISTRICT NUMBER SIX OF CRAWFORD COUNTY TO ELECT MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS on or about \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_ AT \_\_\_\_\_: \_\_\_\_\_ .M."

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-284-226, a Petition was filed with the Crawford County Court by FIRE DISTRICT NUMBER SIX OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, INC. Said Petition filed with the Crawford County Court asked that an ordinance to convert the association to a fire protection district be issued by the Crawford County Quorum Court within 60 days of filing.

**WHEREAS**, said Petition contained a request by the governing body of FIRE DISTRICT NUMBER SIX OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, INC. for the conversion of a fire department serving outside a city or town to a fire protection district pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 14-284-226 within designated portions of Crawford County, Arkansas.

**WHEREAS**, said Petition also contained a request for an assessment be made on assessed property within the district and be collected from the landowners to finance the operation of FIRE DISTRICT NUMBER SIX OF CRAWFORD COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT.

**WHEREAS**, the Crawford County Quorum Court has legislative authority delegated to it by the State of Arkansas, and the State of Arkansas reserved certain powers making the delegation of legislative authority limited in nature as set forth in Section 1 of Amendment 55 of the Arkansas Constitution (county quorum courts are vested with powers to legislate locally, except for any legislative authority "denied by law").

**WHEREAS**, in pertinent part, Arkansas Code Annotate § 14-14-807 places upon the Crawford County Quorum Court statutory prohibitions on its legislative powers and subject it to provisions contained in said statute; specifically, it is legally mandated that the Crawford County Quorum Court conduct itself in accordance with “all [state] laws directing or requiring a county government to carry out function or provide any service,” as well as all state laws “establishing... legislative procedures or requirements for county government.”

**WHEREAS**, Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-284-226 was amended and went into effect via emergency clause in 2019, and the statute, as amended, directs and requires the Crawford County Quorum Court to approve any request by petition duly authorized and received from a rural volunteer fire department within the county. Therefore, the Crawford County Quorum Court has been directed to carry out a function by state law, and has a plain and specific duty, positively required by law, calling for no use of discretion or exercise of judgment, and legislative power to do otherwise has been denied by laws of this state, and thus, same is not vested herewith.

**WHEREAS**, Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-284-226 requires the Crawford County Quorum Court to grant a request by petition within sixty (60) days of its receipt and upon its approval an election is to be held to elect members of the Board of Commissioners.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** Having had an opportunity to obtain answers to any questions the Quorum Court may have had within sixty (60) days of filing the Petition, the Quorum Court hereby designates the boundaries of FIRE DISTRICT NUMBER SIX OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, INC. as a fire protection district to be legally-known as FIRE DISTRICT NUMBER SIX OF CRAWFORD COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT (the DISTRICT);

**SECTION 2.** Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-284-201 *et seq*, an assessment shall be made on assessed property within the district to be collected from landowners to finance the operation of the FIRE DISTRICT NUMBER SIX OF CRAWFORD COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT;

**SECTION 3.** Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-284-208, the Quorum Court of Crawford County hereby directs a meeting and election to be held at the FIRE DISTRICT NUMBER SIX OF CRAWFORD COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT fire station located at 1022 Pleasant Valley Rd. VinBulah, AR on \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_ for the purpose of nominating and electing the Board of Commissioners for the district;

**SECTION 4.** Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-284-208, there shall be five (5) Commissioners elected by Qualified Electors;

**SECTION 5.** Nominations for the Commissioners shall be taken prior to the election from the Qualified Electors present at the meeting to be held prior to the election;

**SECTION 6.** The Commissioners shall serve staggered terms in the following manner:

Positions 1-2 shall serve initial terms of two (2) years; and  
Positions 3-5 shall serve initial terms of three (3) years;

**SECTION 7.** After completion of initial terms, all successor members shall serve terms of three years and results declared under the law and in the manner provided for special elections and only qualified voters residing in the portion of the county in which the District is located shall have the right to vote at the election. Subsequent elections for commissioners shall be held on the second Tuesday of December, with the first such election to take place on Tuesday, December 14, 2021 at a time to be determined by the Commissioners. "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT; AND FOR AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING QUALIFIED ELECTORS WITHIN FIRE DISTRICT 7 OF CRAWFORD COUNTY TO ELECT MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS on or about \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_ AT \_\_\_\_\_: \_\_\_\_\_ .M."

WHEREAS, in accordance with Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-284-226, a request by petition was filed with the Crawford County Court by Said request by petition filed with the Crawford County Court asked that an ordinance to convert the association to a fire protection district be issued by the Crawford County Quorum Court within 60 days of filing;

WHEREAS, said petition contained a request by the governing body of DISTRICT 7 AREA RURAL FIRE ASSOCIATION OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, INC. for the conversion of a fire department serving outside a city or town to a Fire protection district pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 14-284-226 within designated portions of Crawford County, Arkansas;

WHEREAS, said Petition also contained a request for an assessment be made on assessed property within the district and be collected from the landowners to finance the operation of DISTRICT 7 AREA RURAL FIRE ASSOCIATION OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, INC;

WHEREAS, the Crawford County Quorum Court has legislative authority delegated to it by the State of Arkansas, and the State of Arkansas reserved certain powers making the delegation of legislative authority limited in nature as set forth in Section I of Amendment 55 of the Arkansas Constitution (county quorum courts are vested with powers to legislate locally, except for any legislative authority "denied by law");

**WHEREAS**, in pertinent part, Arkansas Code Annotate § 14-14-807 places upon the Crawford County Quorum Court statutory prohibitions on its legislative powers and subject it to provisions contained in said statute; specifically, it is legally mandated that the Crawford County Quorum Court conduct itself in accordance with “all [state] laws directing or requiring a county government to carry out function or provide any service,” as well as all state laws “establishing... legislative procedures or requirements for county government;”

**WHEREAS**, Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-284-226 was amended and went into effect via emergency clause in 2019, and the statute, as amended, directs and requires the Crawford County Quorum Court to approve any request by petition duly authorized and received from a rural volunteer fire department within the county. Therefore, the Crawford County Quorum Court has been directed to carry out a function by state law, and has a plain and specific duty, positively required by law, calling for no use of discretion or exercise of judgment, and legislative power to do otherwise has been denied by laws of this state, and thus, same is not vested herewith;

**WHEREAS**, Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-284-226 requires the Crawford County Quorum Court to grant a request by petition within sixty (60) days of its receipt and upon its approval an election is to be held to elect members of the Board of Commissioners;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** Having had an opportunity to obtain answers to any questions the Quorum Court may have had within sixty (60) days of filing the Petition, the Quorum Court hereby designates the boundaries of DISTRICT 7 AREA RURAL FIRE ASSOCIATION OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, INC. as a “*Fire Protection District*” to be legally-known as FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT 7 OF CRAWFORD COUNTY (the DISTRICT);

**SECTION 2.** Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-284-201 *et seq*, an assessment shall be made on assessed property within the district to be collected from landowners to finance the operation of the DISTRICT;

**SECTION 3.** Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-284-208, the Quorum Court of Crawford County hereby directs a meeting and election to be held at the DISTRICT fire station located at 137 N Kibler Hwy, Alma, AR on \_\_\_\_\_ 20\_\_\_\_ for the purpose of nominating and electing the Board of Commissioner(s) for the DISTRICT;

**SECTION 4.** Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-284-208, there shall be five (5) Commissioners elected by Qualified Electors;

**SECTION 5.** Nominations for the Commissioners shall be taken prior to the election from the Qualified Electors present at the meeting to be held prior to the election;

**SECTION 6.** The Commissioners shall serve staggered terms in the following manner:

Positions 1-2 shall serve initial terms of two (2) years; and

Positions 3-5 shall serve initial terms of three (3) years;

**SECTION 7.** After completion of initial terms, all successor members shall serve terms of three years and results declared under the law and in the manner provided for special elections and only qualified voters residing in the portion of the county in which the District is located shall have the right to vote at the election. Subsequent elections for commissioners shall be held on the second Tuesday of December, with the first such election to take place on Tuesday, December 14, 2021 at a time to be determined by the Commissioners. The first election shall be for positions 1 and 2, with the next election to be for positions 3-5. Elections for Positions 1-2 shall be every three (3) years after 2021 and elections for Positions 3-5 shall be every three (3) years after the 2022 election.

**SECTION 8. Severability.** In the event any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, subparagraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining provisions of this ordinance, as if such invalid or unconstitutional provision were not originally a part of this ordinance.

**SECTION 9. Repealer.** All ordinances, resolutions, bylaws, and other matters inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
