QUORUM COURT JOURNAL OF PROCEEDINGS

The Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas met February 22, 2021, for the second regular meeting of the year. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Circuit Courtroom #2, 220 South 4th Street, Van Buren, Arkansas. Crawford County Judge Gilstrap presiding. David Dunagin, legal counselor was present. Roll was called. Members present were Justices Atwell, Carolan, Cox, DeCroo, Harvey, Johnson, Morrison, Myers, Peppas, Perry, Shaffer and Woodruff with Justice Wahlmeier absent.

The minutes of the last regular meeting and reports were presented. Justice Peppas moved to approve and second by Justice Woodruff and unanimous voice vote the minutes and reports were approved as written.

The minutes of the personnel and budget committee meetings, Justice Peppas made the motion to approve, second by Justice DeCroo and unanimous voice vote the minutes were approved as written.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: Justice Harvey said he had stage one of the environmental report which everything is going, slowly but surely. Alma has now went on grid with their electrical project. Mayor Martin said they are starting phase II which will be up around the high school. County Judge Gilstrap stated that WAPDD put a package together, which was passed out to the Quorum Court to look over the grants that they have done in this region. We are paying out to WAPDD \$10,300.00 which comes out of county general and public safety.

JUDGES NOTE: (1) Judge stated that the road department worked almost 1100 hours of comp time during this snow storm, what I am going to do starting this Friday is to work four, eight hour days and let them off eight hours on Friday's. The reason that I am doing this is to let them all off at the same time so I will have a full crew for the four days that they will be all working. (2) Mayor Isenhower spoke for all the surrounding mayors in Crawford County concerning Ordinance #2018-28, how the county jail fees of \$40.00 are being charged to all the municipalities. Judge Gilstrap suggested that this go before the Facilities/Technology Committee for further discussion, Justice Morrison made the motion, second by Justice Cox. (3) A group of Crawford County residents petitioned the Quorum Court at this meeting to make Crawford County a Second Amendment and Bill of Rights sanctuary. Leigh Wendlandt, Steve Whitlock and John Riordan spoke on behalf of this committee. Quorum Court attorney David Dunagin stated that legislator that has been passed says "no municipality can pass any regulations dealing with firearms according to Arkansas statue §14 - 16 - 504" this states that any lawful government "shall not in act any ordinance for regulations pertaining to or regulate in any manner the ownership, transfer, transportation, caring or possession of

firearms except otherwise provided by state or federal law. If we do this we may lose our insurance coverage with the Association of Arkansas Counties. We see no problem passing a resolution encouraging the legislation to address this, but it is our position that this has to be addressed by legislation, we are not the proper agency to do that. Prosecuting Attorney Rinda Baker, Jacob Howell and I believe how to go about this is by resolution not an ordinance. Justice Peppas stated that he would sponsor the resolution. Instead of passing Rainwater's Ordinance, the court will work on a resolution to make sure that the language is consistent with the current laws. Attorney Jacob Howell will look over this before bringing it back to the Quorum. (4) Justice Harvey was appointed to represent the Quorum Court at the Association of Arkansas Counties, Justice Peppas made the motion, second by Justice Cox.

(3) Justice Peppas inquired when the courthouse might be opening back up an Judge Gilstrap said once the 2nd shot was in the employees arm that is wanting the Covid-19 shot which we have a list of about 33 city employees and 44 county employees. Once they open up phase 1-B and the 2nd shot is administered I will look into opening the courthouse, but right now I am not ready.





AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CRAWFORD COUNTY EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION PLAN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of Crawford County to provide fair and equitable pay to all employee's level of skill, responsibility, education and experience; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Crawford County Employee Compensation Plan, it is important to maintain uniformity in the rate of pay of all temporary or seasonal employees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: Subject to the appropriations of the Quorum Court and the annual budget or any amendments thereto, of any county department, and upon approval of the Quorum Court, if necessary, the hourly wage of any temporary, seasonal, contract labor and extra help County employee shall be paid Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) per hour gross wages.

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-10

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF CRAWFORD, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:
AN ORDINANCE AFFIRMING CRAWFORD COUNTY'S COMMITMENT TO GUARD AGAINST ANY ENCROACHMENT ON INDIVIDUAL LIBERTY RIGHTS

Whereas, Crawford County residents have a long-standing belief in the Bill of Rights of the United States Constitution and the Declaration of Rights in the Arkansas Constitution.

Whereas, as elected officials, we are sworn to uphold both the U.S. Constitution and the Arkansas Constitution in our Oath of Office.

Whereas, there is community perception that time-honored, individual liberty rights, enumerated in the U.S. Constitution and the Arkansas Constitution, are under attack, particularly the right to keep and bear arms.

Whereas, the Quorum Court members of Crawford County want to be counted among those who stand for the right to keep and bear arms to preserve life and liberty – not destroying it – and do so with a firm reliance upon the origin of the right to keep and bear arms which is, first of all, the natural right and duty of preservation of self and others, and secondly, so that we may remain a government for the people and not subject to a government over the people.

Whereas, in adopting this ordinance, we do so declaring not only our rights under the Constitutions of both the United States and the State of Arkansas but also declaring our natural, God-given rights in the same manner as did our founding fathers on July 4, 1776: "...that all men are created equal, that their Creator endows them with certain unalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness. That to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed."

Whereas, in Arkansas (per Arkansas Constitution, Article 2, Section 12): "No power of suspending or setting aside the law or laws of the State, shall ever be exercised, except by the General Assembly."

Whereas, (per Ark. Code Ann. 14-16-504) "a local unit of government [in Arkansas] shall no enact any ordinance or regulation pertaining to, or regulate in any other manner, the ownership, transfer, transportation, carrying, or possession of firearms, except as otherwise provided by state or federal law."

Whereas, the Quorum Court of Crawford County wants to do what it legally can do to require/encourage the State of Arkansas to use its inherent authority as a sovereign state government within the United States, a republican-democracy, to nullify – treat as void and unenforceable – any act of the U.S. Congress, all in an effort to keep the federal government within

its constitutionally limited/defined boundaries and thereby protect the people of Arkansas from deprivation of their natural and constitutional right to keep and bear arms.

Whereas, it is our sworn (Arkansas Constitution, Article 19, Section 20) duty as the elected representatives of the people, under U.S. Constitution Amendment 10 and under Arkansas Constitution Article 2, Section 1, to do our part to guard against any unconstitutional denial of, disparagement of, or encroachment on any of the enumerated or unenumerated rights that the U.S. Constitution, Amendment 9, and Arkansas Constitution, Article 2, Section 29, promise are to be retained by the people, excepted from the general powers of the government, and forever remain inviolate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

- 1. Crawford County is declared a "Second Amendment County": As an expression of Crawford County's desire to join the present nationwide effort to affirmatively state county government support for the U.S. Constitution, Bill of Rights, Second Amendment, and the statewide effort to affirmatively state county government support for the Arkansas Constitution, Article 2, Declaration of Rights, Section 5, as written and historically interpreted and applied, Crawford County, Arkansas, is hereby officially designated a "Second Amendment County."
- 2. Right to keep and bear arms is protected by our Constitution: Crawford County officials and employees shall uphold each and every provision of the Bill of Rights in the U.S. Constitution and the Declaration of Rights in the Arkansas Constitution and, specifically, Crawford County officials and employees shall uphold the right of the citizens of this county to "keep and bear arms" as guaranteed by the U.S. Constitution, Amendment 2, and the Arkansas Constitution, Article 2, Declaration of Rights, Section 5.
- 3. Unconstitutional laws are void: It is declared to be the official policy of Crawford County that the U.S. Constitution's Second Amendment right and the Arkansas Constitution's Article 2, Section 5, right of citizens to keep and bear arms will be honored by the officials and employees of Crawford County as a constitutionally protected individual liberty right and that any act of any legislature that abrogates Amendment 2 to the U.S. Constitution or Article 2, Section 5, of the Arkansas Constitution, will be treated as void and unenforceable in Crawford County.
- 4. Liberty rights belong to the people: Since it is clear from both the U.S. Constitution, Amendment 9, and the Arkansas Constitution, Article 2, Section 29, that individual liberty rights (including the right to keep and bear arms) belong to the people and are to be forever retained by the people, Crawford county officials and employees shall neither interpret nor construe any legislation in any manner that would deny or disparage the Bill of Rights or the Declaration of Rights and shall guard against any encroachments on the U.S. Bill of Rights and the Arkansas Declaration of Rights (including the right to keep and bear arms).

- 5. Liberty rights shall forever remain inviolate: Crawford County officials and employees shall support the U.S. Constitution, Amendment 9, and the Arkansas Constitution, Article 2, Section 29, concepts that the individual liberty rights enumerated in the U.S. Bill of Rights and the Arkansas Declaration of rights (including the right to keep and bear arms) are excepted out of the general powers of government and shall forever remain inviolate.
- 6. Due process of law: Crawford County officials and employees shall use the county's state political subdivision police powers, reserved to the state by the Tenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution, and those gathering with the consent of and in support of, as is necessary and constitutionally justified in order to maintain order, ensure security, and keep the peace in the county all to be done in a manner that both recognizes the people's individual liberty rights which shall forever remain inviolate and complies with the constitutional requirements of due process.
- 7. Redress of wrongs: In addition to asserting his or her rights of due process, any person who believes his or her right to keep and bear arms, as enumerated by the Second Amendment and/or Article 2, Section 5, has been violated may seek redress through civil process for, in Arkansas "[e]very person is entitled to certain remedy in the laws for all injuries or wrongs he may receive in his person, property or character, he ought to obtain justice freely without purchase; completely, and without denial; promptly and without delay; conformably to the laws." Arkansas Constitution, Article 2, Section 13.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTED PURSUANT TO ACT 1112 OF 2017, AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION OF WARREN'S REC ROOM & GRILL FOR A PRIVATE CLUB/RESTAURANT TO BE LOCATED AT 1437 WEST NEWBERRY ROAD, ALMA, CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, Act 1112 of 2017 requires applicants for private club license obtain approval of the governing body of the city or county where the private club is to be located; and

WHEREAS, Warren's Rec Room & Grill has held a private club license for many years at 1437 West Newberry Road, Alma, Crawford County, Arkansas, offering adult beverages to compliment fine dining; and

WHEREAS, Warren's Rec Room & Grill must reapply with the ABC for a private club license at the location described herein; and

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas has considered the request of Warren's Rec Room & Grill for authority to file a private club/restaurant application with the ABC; and

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court of Crawford County finds the application of Warren's Rec Room & Grill will promote the public convenience and advantage through providing community hospitality and increasing sales tax revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas:

Article I. The request of Warren's Rec Room & Grill, Jae Cutler Managing Agent, for authority to file a private club application at 1437 West Newberry Road, Alma, Crawford County, be, and it hereby is, approved by the Quorom Court of Crawford County, Arkansas.

Article II. Pursuant to Act 1112 of 2017, Warren's Rec Room & Grill is hereby authorized to file a private club application with the Department of Finance and Administration, Alcoholic Beverage Control Division, for the location at 1437 West Newberry Road, Alma, Crawford County, Arkansas. A copy of this Ordinance shall be provided to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division, Department of Finance and Administration along with the ABC private club application of Warren's Rec Room & Grill.

Article III. As this ordinance concerns a matter affecting the lives and property of the people of Crawford County, specifically the right of community hospitality and affects the tax revenue of the County, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
