QUORUM COURT JOURNAL OF PROCEEDINGS

The Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas met March 15, 2021, for the third regular meeting of the year. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Circuit Courtroom #2, 220 South 4th Street, Van Buren, Arkansas. Crawford County Judge Gilstrap presiding. Jacob Howell, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, legal counselor was present. Roll was called. Members present were Justices Roger Atwell, Carolan, Cox, DeCroo, Harvey, Johnson, Morrison, Myers, Peppas, Perry, Shaffer, and Woodruff. Justice Wahlmeier absent

The minutes of the last regular meeting and reports were presented. Justice Woodruff moved to approve, second by Justice Atwell and unanimous voice vote the minutes and reports were approved as written.

The minutes of the Budget Committee meeting on 2/16/2021, Justice Atwell made the motion to approve, second by Justice Carolan. Also minutes from the Personnel Committee meeting 2/16/202 were presented. Justice Peppas moved to approve, second by Justice Perry.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: (1) Justice Harvey had former State Representative Charlotte Douglas to speak on the 100 Families program. Ms. Douglas spoke on how the 100 Family program works and how Sebastian and Crawford County had some of the highest incarceration rates in the state. Once the incarceration started rising so did the foster care. We are one of the first groups that put together the fact that probably these parents that are going to prison were putting these families in crisis. The governor put together some task forces and ultimately formed what we call restored hope. So the governor gave some grant money to Sebastian County and White County where the numbers were the worse. After about a year of meeting with community members and put together a coalition in Sebastian County we came up with what we call 100 Families. We came up with a system that worked with housing, Harbor House, Western Arkansas Guidance, car mechanics, people that work with lawns and pest control. We assess every family that is sent to us in a 13 point assessment we figure out exactly where they are in crises, then we start connecting them with community resources that are here in the county. Since the middle of November we have passed over 100 families that was referred to us with over 277 children involved. Crawford County leads the state in the best results due to the help our adult education which is so very strong thanks to Debbie Faubus-Kendrick. I come to you tonight not asking for money but I am telling you I am trying to save you money. We are trying to tell you that they can provide for their families. All of the Judges in Crawford County have been working with us to divert them to job training instead of putting them back in jail for 30 days. If you want to get involved just give us a call we would appreciate any help.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC:

JUDGES NOTE: (1) Road department is cutting the comp time down, which was obtained during the snow days that we had, by taking off on Friday's until the time is exhausted. (2) Saturday, March 13, 2021 we gave out around 300 Covid-19 shots at the EOC building for the county and city employees. (3) Judge Gilstrap stated that he had a soft date of reopening the courthouse for April 26, 2021 if all goes as plan and no spikes hit us because of spring break and by following the governor's plans for the state.

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-13

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF CRAWFORD,
STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:
AN ORDINANCE SETTING DEPUTY CORONER PER CALL COMPENSATION.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF
CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

Article 1. Deputy Coroners are contracted with for the purpose of responding to calls, which may occur at any time. Deputy Coroners are paid per call.

Article 2. Deputy Coroners shall be paid \$75 per call, less payroll and withholding amounts.

Article 3. No more than one (1) Deputy Coroner shall be paid for any call, except for an assist call.

Article 4. Deputy Coroners shall not respond to more than twenty-five (25) calls in any calendar month. This limit includes assist calls. In the event of an emergency situation making it necessary for Deputy Coroners to respond to more than twenty-five (25) calls in any calendar month, authorization for payment of any call in excess of twenty-five (25) shall require approval from the Quorum Court.

Article 5. To receive payment, a Deputy Coroner must turn in a call sheet to the County Clerk. Said call sheet shall include the date of call, the address responded to, the type of call, and if an assist call, the reason an assist was necessary.

Article 6. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions of the ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision, and to this end the provisions of the Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Article 7. In order to protect the public health, peace, safety, and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the date of its passing.

Article 8. Any ordinance or resolution, or parts of the same, in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent such conflict exists.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2018-28, SETTING DAILY JAIL FEES CHARGED TO MUNICIPALITIES FOR HOUSING PRISONERS IN THE COUNTY JAIL; AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES

ARTICLE 1. Prior to charging a daily fee, the jail shall assess a \$40.00 initial holding fee. Once a prisoner has been in the custody of the jail for greater than twenty-four (24) hours, the daily fee shall be charged.

ARTICLE 2. The \$40.00 daily fee charged for each prisoner shall remain.

ARTICLE 3. If any provision or section of this ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or sections of this Ordinance to such end the provisions or section of the Ordinance are declared severable.

ARTICLE 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
