### QUORUM COURT JOURNAL OF PROCEEDINGS

The Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas met June 21, 2021, for the sixth regular meeting of the year. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Circuit Courtroom #2, 220 South 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Van Buren, Arkansas. Judge Gilstrap presiding. Jacob Howell, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, legal counselor was present. Roll was called. Members present were Justices Atwell, Cox, DeCuro, Harvey, Johnson, Myers, Peppas, Perry, Shaffer, Wahlmeier, Woodruff. Justice Carolan and Justice Morrison were absent.

The minutes of the May 17, 2021 meeting and reports were presented. Justice Peppas moved to approve, second by Justice DeCuro and unanimous voice vote the minutes were approved as written.

The minutes of the Personnel and Budget Committee meetings for May 17, 2021 were presented. Justice Woodruff moved to approve, second by Justice Wahlmeier and unanimous voice vote the minutes were approved as written.

#### COMMITTEE REPORTS:

#### COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC:

JUDGES NOTE: (1) Judge Gilstrap talked about the Recovery Funds from the State and Federal. I have ask legal counsel Jacob Howell for guidance on these funds. AAC tells us it is December, 2024 to allocate these funds and then you have to have your project completed by December, 2026. It is set up in an interest bearing account and the interest would be ours and we don't have to turn the interest back. We will as a group, set down and a have a discussion on the \$12,000,000.00, investment whether it be a new courthouse or a capital project that would benefit the county. We have to be careful and trace all the funding. (2) The flooding is in the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management's hands and I am not happy with the outcome. I thought they were going to combine the "Flooding and Tornado" as one, but they are separating each one on their own since it was five days in between each incident. When it goes over three days it is considered separate incident, with the second incident the "Tornado" will should get 35% reimbursement instead of 75%. Now where I am really disappointed is FEMA on the "Flooding" where we were hit hard they sent a specialist in to go out with Brad Thomas, DEM official and Chris Keith, superintendent of the road department all went out and spent a whole day driving and looking at sights. They agreed that it was \$800,000.00 worth of damage that they documented that day. The report was sent in to Denton, Texas for review and when he sent it back, we had \$67,000.00 worth of damage, we are appealing this report. (3) The roof on the courthouse, we did not get our Historic Preservation Grant, so I have reached out to the governors liaison on emergency management side of things to get us some help thru the Economic Development Commission, which we have a resolution that is going to take care of the damage part. The Economic Development Commission is going to send us \$247,000.00 to help put a new roof on the

courthouse. (4) The courtroom has been slow about getting it dried out, they have actually transported all of the pews to Little Rock to help protect them. They gave us a date of August, 1 or August 15, 2021 to get Division I back up and running. (5) The new 911 Director, Joanie Best will start her new job on Monday, June 28, 2021. (6) Now that Juneteenth has passed as a legal Federal holiday, I am asking you as the Quorum, what do you want to do and do we observe it this year or start next year, since the timing was off to take advantage of it this year? Legal Counsel, Jacob Howell and all Quorum Court members agreed to add it to the hand book for next year. (7) Elaine Stanfield spoke on the Diamond Center and its grant and what the engineers have come up with on what the area is to be used for. A couple of weeks ago some vandals have come in and done some damages to the bathrooms and we are now working on the insurance for that. There was 230 young ladies that had signed up for spring ball. The Crawford County Girl Softball Association has done a wonderful job and anytime you want to volunteer you are welcome to come and help. We have applied for other grants and we have received a \$20,000.00 grant with Blue and You and have also applied for a \$270,000.00 with ARDot. Judge Gilstrap stated that they did have a plan because there is a drainage problem that runs across the ball field hopefully we can correct this in the near future.

Whereas, pursuant to Federal Fair Labor Standard Act, certain law enforcement  
officers or employees are not required to be compensated monetarily for time worked  
beyond 160 hours in a 28 day period.

Whereas, though not required, it is permissible to compensate monetarily for said  
time.

SECTION 1. Sheriff Deputies and Jailers shall be paid those employees hourly  
wage for hours worked between 160-171 hours in any 28 day pay period.

SECTION 2. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall  
not affect other provisions of the ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid  
provision, and to this end, the provisions of the Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance being
