1. Justice Mark Shaffer to introduce Ordinance 2022-5: BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED: AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUDGET ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-52 TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS AND APPROVE ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURES TO THE CRAWFORD COUNTY 2022 BUDGET FOR VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS; TRANSFERS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

2. Justice Mitch Carolan to introduce Ordinance 2022-6: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2015-3 IN ORDER TO EXTEND, FROM SEPTEMBER 30, 2023 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2031, THE ONE PERCENT (1%) SALES AND USE TAX LEVIED BY CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS UNDER ORDINANCE NO. 05-2007, THE NET COLLECTIONS OF WHICH SHALL, AFTER DEDUCTION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CHARGES OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE COUNTY AND EACH MUNICIPALITY THEREIN BASED UPON POPULATION AS DETERMINED BY THE STATE LEGISLATION AUTHORIZING THE TAX AND USED AS FOLLOWS: THE NET COLLECTIONS RECEIVED BY THE MUNICIPALITIES SHALL BE USED BY EACH MUNICIPALITY TO ASSIST IN FINANCING THE GENERAL OPERATIONS AND OTHER PURPOSES OF ITS GOVERNMENT AS DETERMINED FROM TIME TO TIME BY ITS GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING RETIREMENT OF BONDS ISSUED BY A MUNICIPALITY AND APPROVED BY ITS VOTERS; AND THE NET COLLECTIONS TO BE RECEIVED BY THE COUNTY SHALL BE USED BY THE COUNTY AS FOLLOWS: 45% FOR THE COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT; 40% FOR PUBLIC SAFETY; AND 15% FOR GENERAL OPERATIONS AND OTHER PURPOSES OF COUNTY GOVERNMENT; PROVIDED HOWEVER THAT THE COUNTY'S SHARE OF NET COLLECTIONS MAY ALSO BE USED TO RETIRE BONDS ISSUED BY THE COUNTY AND APPROVED BY THE VOTERS SO LONG AS THE PERCENTAGE OF NET COLLECTIONS PLEDGED ARE LIMITED TO THE PERCENTAGE ALLOCATED AS FOLLOWS: BONDS FOR ROADS – 45%; BONDS FOR PUBLIC SAFETY – 40%; AND BONDS FOR OTHER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS – 15%; AND PRESCRIBING OTHER MATTERS PERTAINING THERETO.
3. Justice Mark Shaffer to introduce Ordinance 2022-7: AN ORDINANCE FOR COMPLIANCE WITH A.C.A. §14-14-1202, AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH AN ELECTED OFFICIAL OR EMPLOYEE OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

QUORUM COURT JOURNAL OF PROCEDURES

JANUARY 19,2022

The Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas met January 19, 2022, for the first regular meeting of the year. The meeting was held at 7:00 p.m. in the Circuit Courtroom II, 220 South 4th St., Van Buren, Arkansas. Judge Gilstrap presiding. Rinda Baker, Prosecuting Attorney legal counsel was present. Roll was called. Members present were Justice Atwell, Carolan, DeCroo, Harvey, Johnson, Morrison, Myers, Peppas, Perry, Shaffer, Wahlmeier and Woodruff. District #1 position of Jason Cox is vacant.

The minutes of 12/20/2021 Regular meeting was presented. Justice Harvey moved to approve, second by Justice Atwell and unanimous voice vote to approve as written.

The minutes of the 12/20/2021 budget meeting was presented. Justice Harvey moved to approve, second by Justice Perry and unanimous voice vote to approve as written.

REPORTS: Justice Decroo moved to approve the monthly reports, second by Justice Woodruff and unanimous voice vote to approve.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: (1) Justice Wahlmeier gave a summary of where we are standing on the apprentice program which has been compromised. In the county's contract with Apprentice Information System, we are not being charged. To Apprentice's knowledge no personal information was stolen. (2) Justice Harvey touched on some topics that was discussed in a board meeting concerning the port. Judge Gilstrap also discussed that they were working on the Plaquemines Parish that is located between New Orleans and the Gulf of Mexico on the Mississippi River. Justice Harvey also stated that the upcoming extension of I-49 was discussed in this meeting.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC:

JUDGES NOTES: (1) Justice Harvey was appointed to represent the Crawford County Quorum Court at the Association of Arkansas Counties meetings. (2) We have now signed a contract for the North Rudy Road drainage project which will go from Old Dollard Way to Billy Trail. This will be a \$435,00.00 project which is being helped by a grant. Another project that I gave a verbal approve on for state aid is the Old Uniontown Hwy. from #59

Hwy. to Pine Hollow Road which is approximately 1.6 miles. The cost will be \$413,000.00 that will be paid out of our State Aid Fund. (3) Mulberry Silver Bridge – I have now signed an agreement with ARDOT and Franklin County to let Mayor Baxter have the bridge. This was a joint grant between Franklin County and Crawford County. This will be \$400,000.00 cost for each county that is being paid out of Federal grant monies.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-2: AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUDGET ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-52 TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS AND APPROVE ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURES TO THE CRAWFORD COUNTY 2022 BUDGET FOR VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS; TRANSFERS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. On motion by Justice Shaffer, second by Justice DeCuro, Ordinance No. 2022-2 was presented. After reading in its entirety Justice Woodruff moved to approve, second by Justice Wahlmeier. There was no discussion by the court, roll call vote, 11 yeas, 1 nay and 1 vacant position.
3. ORDINANCE NO. 2022-3: AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE DEADLINE TO TURN IN DEPARTMENT BUDGETS. On motion by Justice Shaffer, second by Justice Peppas Ordinance No. 2022-3 was presented. After reading in its entirety Justice DeCuro moved to approve, second by Justice Morrison. There was some discussion by the court, roll call vote 12 yeas, 1 vacant position.
4. ORDINANCE NO. 2022-4: AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUDGET ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-52 TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS AND APPROVE ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURES TO THE CRAWFORD COUNTY 2022 BUDGET FOR VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS; TRANSFERS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. Justice Shaffer made a motion to amend and add Ordinance No. 2022-4 second by Justice Peppas. Unanimous voice vote to amend and add Ordinance No. 2022-4. On motion by Justice Shaffer to place Ordinance No. 2022-4 on the floor as amended, second by Justice Atwell. After reading in its entirety as amended, Justice Peppas moved to approve, second by Justice DeCuro. There was some discussion, roll call vote 12 yeas, 1 vacant position.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC: (1) Judge Gilstrap stated that in the final ruling of the American Rescue Act they have become a little more lenient. (2) Elaine Standfield wanted everyone to remember our retired Justice of the Peace, Mary Blount in our prayers, she is in rehab due to a stroke. Also, they are fixing to start on the new roof at the Courthouse this month

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD COUNTY,
ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2015-3 IN ORDER TO EXTEND, FROM SEPTEMBER 30, 2023 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2031, THE ONE PERCENT (1%) SALES AND USE TAX LEVIED BY CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS UNDER ORDINANCE NO. 05-2007, THE NET COLLECTIONS OF WHICH SHALL, AFTER DEDUCTION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CHARGES OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE COUNTY AND EACH MUNICIPALITY THEREIN BASED UPON POPULATION AS DETERMINED BY THE STATE LEGISLATION AUTHORIZING THE TAX AND USED AS FOLLOWS: THE NET COLLECTIONS RECEIVED BY THE MUNICIPALITIES SHALL BE USED BY EACH MUNICIPALITY TO ASSIST IN FINANCING THE GENERAL OPERATIONS AND OTHER PURPOSES OF ITS GOVERNMENT AS DETERMINED FROM TIME TO TIME BY ITS GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING RETIREMENT OF BONDS ISSUED BY A MUNICIPALITY AND APPROVED BY ITS VOTERS; AND THE NET COLLECTIONS TO BE RECEIVED BY THE COUNTY SHALL BE USED BY THE COUNTY AS FOLLOWS: 45% FOR THE COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT; 40% FOR PUBLIC SAFETY; AND 15% FOR GENERAL OPERATIONS AND OTHER PURPOSES OF COUNTY GOVERNMENT; PROVIDED HOWEVER THAT THE COUNTY'S SHARE OF NET COLLECTIONS MAY ALSO BE USED TO RETIRE BONDS ISSUED BY THE COUNTY AND APPROVED BY THE VOTERS SO LONG AS THE PERCENTAGE OF NET COLLECTIONS PLEDGED ARE LIMITED TO THE PERCENTAGE ALLOCATED AS FOLLOWS: BONDS FOR ROADS – 45%; BONDS FOR PUBLIC SAFETY – 40%; AND BONDS FOR OTHER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS – 15%; AND PRESCRIBING OTHER MATTERS PERTAINING THERETO.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 05-2007 adopted February 13, 2007 (“Ordinance No. 05-2007”), an election held May 8, 2007 (the “Tax Election”), and Title 26, Chapter 74, Subchapter 2 of the Arkansas code of 1987 Annotated (the “Authorizing Legislation”), Crawford County, Arkansas (the “County”) has levied a county-wide one percent (1%) sales and use tax (the “Sales and Use Tax”) the net collections of which shall, after deduction of the administrative charges of the State of Arkansas, be distributed to the County and each municipality therein based upon population as determined by the legislation authorizing the tax; and

WHEREAS, the net collections of the Sales and Use Tax received by the municipalities shall be used by each municipality to assist in financing the general operations and other purposes of its government as determined from time to time by its government, including retirement of bonds issued by a municipality and approved by its voters; and

WHEREAS, the net collections of the Sales and Use Tax to be received by the County shall be used by the county as follows: 45% for the county road department; 40% for public safety; and 15% for general operations and other purposes of County government; and

WHEREAS, the County's share of net collections of the Sales and Use Tax may also be used to retire bonds issued by the county and approved by the voters so long as the percentage of net collections pledged are limited to the percentage allocated as follows: bonds for roads – 45%; bonds for public safety – 40%; and bonds for other capital improvements – 15%; and

WHEREAS, the ballot for the Tax Election and Ordinance No. 05-2007 provides that the Sales and Use Tax should be levied for an eight (8) year period that would end on 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Sales and Use Tax was extended by eight (8) additional years to end on September 30, 2023;

WHEREAS, the County proposes to extend the levy of the Sales and Use Tax for an additional eight (8) year period that will end September 30, 2031;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas;

Section 1. That Article 2 of Ordinance No. 05-2007 is hereby amended to read as follows:


“Article 2. The levy of the Sales and Use Tax shall be effective only for a period of twenty-four (24) years. The levy of the Sales and Use Tax shall commence on October 1, 2007 and end on September 30, 2031. The Sales and Use Tax shall be levied and collected only on gross receipts, gross proceeds or sales price for each single transaction in the maximum amount allowed from time to time by Arkansas law, subject to rebates and limitations as required for certain single transactions as from time to time required by Arkansas Statutes.”

Section 2. That the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be separable, and if any provision shall for any reason be held illegal or invalid, it shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance.

Section 3. That Ordinance No. 05-2007, as amended hereby, shall remain and be in full force and affect.


