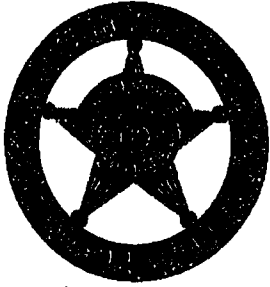

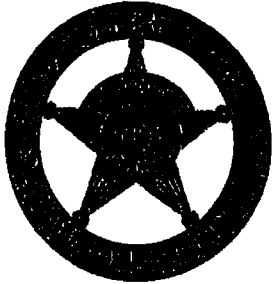

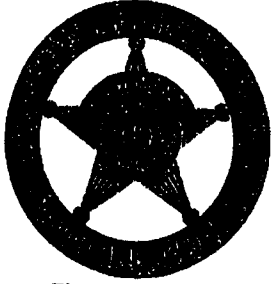

(4) Finally making progress with weather permitting on Old Rouw Road to be able to hard surface it in the spring. We received State Aid which will allow us to do 1.6 miles of Old Uniontown Road, from Hwy. 59 to Pine Hollow Road. This will be an overlay. (5) Just recently we did an agreement with Wave Rural Connect, which is in the Cedarville area and also, we have done an agreement in Mulberry with Windstream. (6) We now have the North Rudy Road drainage project which is about half completed, which is also being done from a grant.

**AN ORDINANCE RECOGNIZING GOOD FRIDAY AND JUNETEENTH AS
OBSERVED HOLIDAYS**

WHEREAS, June 19th, otherwise known as “Juneteenth” is recognized as a holiday and,

WHEREAS, Good Friday, the Friday that occurs immediately before Easter Sunday, is recognized as a holiday and,

WHEREAS, Crawford County should observe said holidays and allow its employees to observe said holidays without penalty and with pay;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD
COUNTY, ARKANSAS:**

SECTION 1. The recognition of June 19th and of Good Friday as County-observed holidays for the purposes of Crawford County Employees is hereby implemented.

SECTION 2. June 19th and Good Friday shall be made additions to the Crawford County Employee Handbook, as amended, to Section 5.2, all other provisions thereof shall remain in effect.

SECTION 3. June 19th shall be observed on that date and Good Friday shall be observed on the Friday occurring immediately before Easter Sunday.

SECTION 4. The Quorum Court hereby finds and declares that the facts set out herein are true and correct.
