The meeting was held at 7:00 p.m in the Circuit Courtroom I, 300 Main Street., Van Buren, Arkansas. Judge Gilstrap presiding. Gentry Wahlmeier, Prosecuting Attorney legal counsel was present. Roll was called. Members present were Justice Atwell, Carolan, DeCuro, Harvey, Johnson, Morrison, Myers, Peppas, Perry, Pinkerton, Shaffer, Wahlmeier, Woodruff.

The minutes of 4/18/2022 Regular meeting was presented. Justice Peppas moved to approve, second by Justice Atwell and unanimous voice vote to approve as written.

The minutes of the 4/18/2022 Personnel meeting was presented. Justice Woodruff moved to approve, second by Justice Perry and unanimous voice vote to approve as written.

The minutes of the 4/18/2022 Budget meeting was presented. Justice Shaffer moved to approve, second by Justice DeCuro and unanimous voice vote to approve as written.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF CRAWFORD,
STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:**

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING A BOND LIMIT FOR HEAVY HAUL PERMITS ON
COUNTY ROADS AMENDING SECTION 92.56 OF COUNTY ROAD STANDARDS
AND PARTIALLY AMENDING ORDINANCE 84-26**

WHEREAS, Crawford County maintains roads in the care of the County in good and working condition and from time to time authorizes heavily laden vehicles and equipment to utilize the roads for transportation; and

WHEREAS, Crawford County has a procedure in place under §92.56 of the County Road Standards for those operating or transporting heavily laden vehicles and equipment to obtain a permit and that process includes obtaining a Surety Bond for excessive wear and tear on County Roads per Crawford County Ordinance 84-26,

[Referenced Section §92.56: "*Any individual or firm desiring to use any county road in any manner that might result in unnecessary damages to the roadway or its drainage facilities or that might result in undue safety hazards to the public, must obtain a special use permit. Activities subject to special use permits includes, but is not limited to, any transporting of construction materials, equipment, or commodity in any equipment, whose gross tonnage would be in excess of the load carrying capacity of the roads over which they travel. County roads are not constructed to sustain heavy loads. Any user of a county road who causes unnecessary damage to it shall be liable for damages equal to repair cost necessary to restore them to their original, preexisting condition. The County Judge shall determine, during negotiations with special use permit applicants, adequate bonding arrangements and amounts, which will guarantee that roads will be restored to preexisting conditions at the conclusion of special use permit activities.*" (Ord. 84-26, passed 08-13-1984) Penalty, see § 92.99]

WHEREAS, those who engage in heavy haul within our County are desirous of certainty and security in their endeavors and an upper limit for the Surety Bond should be established;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD
COUNTY, ARKANSAS:**

SECTION 1. The requirement for the Surety Bond for excessive wear and tear on County Roads as determined by the County Judge shall be set at a minimum of zero Dollars (\$0.00) and a maximum of fifteen thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) unless otherwise

mutually agreed before the issuance of the permit. This is not a limitation on liability for damage to roads and rights-of-way.

SECTION 2. The Crawford County Road Standards shall be amended in conjunction with this ordinance.

SECTION 3. All parts of Crawford County Ordinance 84-26 and the Crawford County Road Standards not in conflict herewith shall remain unchanged. This Ordinance shall not have effect on the basis for establishing the bond amount per § 92.59 of the Crawford County Road Standards nor any other sequential section thereof.

SECTION 4. The Quorum Court hereby finds and declares that the facts set out herein are true and correct.

SECTION 5. The various paragraphs hereof and portions hereof being severable, should any part thereof be declared invalid, for any reason, the remainder hereof shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE: certainty in the use of roads is essential to the public health, safety, and welfare of Crawford County, and the goal can be met by enactment of this ordinance; an emergency is therefore, declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
