





A new pantry in the River Valley in February 2020, Mulberry Community Food Pantry became incorporated as a 501(c)3 the following February. We were granted tax exempt status as a non-profit by the IRS July 13, 2021. Our pantry is non-USDA and can serve any household in Crawford or Franklin counties. What began with small local needs prior to Covid19, rapidly expanded in size and scope. July-August of 2021 we averaged 227 households. A year later it's now 346 households. Covid19 caused an increased need countywide with it rapidly expanding along with current inflation. The county impact of our MCFPantry is ever increasing as individual and household needs continue to increase. We will serve anyone who needs our help irregardless of their income level.

Geographic summary of our 1,451 current households.

Mulberry/Dyer - 61%

Alma - 14%

Van Buren/Cedarville/Rudy - 6%

Mountainburg - 3%

Ozark - 13%

Mulberry Community Food Pantry has been awarded a \$280,000 Community Block Grant. The funds from this grant will expand the size of our current building by about another third. It also includes construction of a freezer and a cooler, both 10 x 20 in size. Our expanded capacity will help us better keep up with the growing needs within our counties. Presently, we are limited on the amount of product we can receive and keep on hand. Once these units are in place, we must ensure the product stays secure and at a safe temp. While a backup generator was not included in the construction plans we've come to realize its necessity in helping us guard against product loss due to power failure.

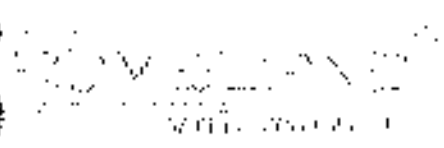

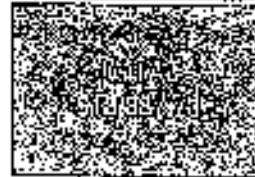

NUMBER 2021-52 TO ESTABLISH PREMIUM PAY OF \$1,500,000.00 AND TO AMEND
THE ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2022, MAKE
ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES, PREMIUM PAY
INCENTIVE FOR ALL ELIGIBLE ESSENTIAL EMPLOYEES FULL TIME AND PART
TIME ONLY.**

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan, Public Law No. 117-2 (March 11, 2021) was adopted into law and provided States, Cities, Counties and Tribal Governments Funds for the purpose of addressing the various adverse impacts of Covid-19 upon these governmental units and society, including premium pay for essential workers defined by Interim Final Rule definitions, in pertinent part, as any work performed by a county employee involving regular in-person interactions or regular physical handling of items that were also handled by others;

WHEREAS, 31 C.F.R. Part 35, the US Treasury Interim Final Rule, sets forth the authority and need for providing premium pay to assure the retention and support for essential workers and public functions.

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court of Crawford County recognizes the need to provide resilience to our local government and provide premium pay including retroactive pay to our County Employees as authorized by the American Rescue Plan and guidance by the United States Treasury;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD
COUNTY, ARKANSAS:**

SECTION 1. The Quorum Court of Crawford County, hereby approves premium pay for eligible county employees employed by the county and have continued their employment with Crawford County. To qualify for premium pay, employees shall work (physically in office and delivering services to the public). Vacation time, sick time, comp time and working from homes does not qualify for premium pay, per ARP guidelines.


