Sheriff Deputies and Jailers, after 40 hours of work per week, shall be eligible for special assignment after approval by the Sheriff or one of his designees, at a rate of pay equal to time and a half pay, or 1 ½ times their regular rate of pay. This shall apply only to those Deputles and Jailers that meet the qualifications set out in the Fair Labor Standards Act.

SECTION 3. All special assignment overtime pay will be paid out of Jail & Law Enforcement County Sales Tax Fund #3428, Line Item #3428-0418-1005 Overtime/Other Premium Comp.


