**SUMMARY**

To serve as the primary contact between the Crawford County Emergency Communications Center (CCECC) and the law enforcement agencies of Crawford County, the fire departments of Crawford County, and Southwest EMS. Telecommunicators will also be the primary contact for the citizens of Crawford County and surrounding areas and agencies. Telecommunicators will process information given by citizens and relay it to the proper emergency service. This position reports directly to the shift supervisor.

**ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES** include the following. Other duties may be assigned. *Note: All CCECC employees are required to provide good customer service to both internal and external customers, maintain positive and effective working relationships with other county employees, and have regular and reliable attendance that is non-disruptive. Must show cooperation and respect to fellow employees and supervisors at all times.*

1. Operate appropriate/multiple radio channels.
2. Answer emergency and non-emergency phone lines.
3. Operate various computer applications.
4. Monitor status of police, fire, and EMS personnel.
5. Respond to a variety of requests from personnel/citizens/other agencies.
6. Regular attendance and timeliness is required.



Whereas, pursuant to Federal Fair Labor Standards Act, certain law enforcement officers or employees are not required to be compensated monetarily for time worked beyond 160 hours in a 28-day period.

Whereas, though not required, it is permissible to compensate monetarily for said time.

**SECTION 1.** Sheriff Deputies and Jailers shall be paid that employee's hourly wage for hours worked between 160-171 hours in any 28 day pay period. This shall apply only to those Deputies and Jailers that meet the qualifications set out in the Fair Labor Standards Act.

**SECTION 2.** Sheriff Deputies and Jailers, after 40 hours of work per week, shall be eligible for special assignment after approval by the Sheriff or one of his designees, at a rate of pay equal to time and a half pay, or 1 ½ times their regular rate of pay. This shall apply only to those Deputies and Jailers that meet the qualifications set out in the Fair Labor Standards Act.

**SECTION 3.** All special assignment overtime pay will be paid out of Jail & Law Enforcement County Sales Tax Fund #3428, Line Item #3428-0418-1005 Overtime/Other Premium Comp.

**SECTION 4.** If any provisions of this Ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions of the ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision, and to this end, the provisions of the ordinance are declared to be severable.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall be retroactive and apply an effective date to July 22, 2022.
