JUNE 20, 2023

The Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas met June 20, 2023, for the sixth regular meeting of the year. The meeting was held at 7:00 p.m. in the Circuit Courtroom I, 300 Main Street., Van Buren, Arkansas. Judge Chris Keith presiding. Kevin Holmes, the Prosecuting Attorney legal counsel was present. Roll was called. Members present: Justice Arnold, Atwell, Beaucham, Carolan, Cox, Jennings, Martin, Morgan, Myers, Peppas, Shaffer, Wahlmeier and Woodruff.

The minutes of 5/15/2023 Regular meeting were presented. Justice Morgan moved to approve, second by Justice Woodruff and unanimous voice vote to approve as written.

The minutes of the 5/15/2023 Personnel and Budget meeting were presented. Justice Peppas moved to approve, second by Justice Martin and unanimous voice vote to approve as written.

REPORTS:

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC: Michael Rich ask the County Judge where the \$60,000.00 special legal fees were being paid out of was it the Library and the Judge Keith stated it was being paid out of fund #1000 which is county general fund.

JUDGES NOTES: (1) The road department just got through replacing a bridge on Wayfarer Drive just north of Alma. (2) Also, we are starting on the overlay on Westville Road from Kibler Hwy. to Industrial Park Road. (3) Then in July we will be starting on Rudy Road which comes up out of Rudy to Pecan Grove Road with the help of state aid. (4) We had to ask for an extension of the Pointer Trail East Drainage Project due to some unforeseen utilities. (5) We just recently had a storm, and they are also working on clearing some trees off the roads. (6) Also, you will notice that we are still in the process of restoring the old windows in the courthouse thanks to a restoration grant, which this project is taking a little longer than expected. (7) We do have parts of the roof on at the Circuit Clerks Office, they have all the shingles on it and they are waiting on some tools to come in to finish the flat part which is expected to take 4 to 5 weeks. (8) The new 911 Call Center now have blocks laid and hopefully the walls will be coming up soon, we are having a meeting next week to get the projected date of completion and once this gets done, we will have a grand opening and a ribbon cutting. (9) We are going after a parks and recreation grant for the Diamond Center out on Kibler Road. Hopefully we will put a new walking trail around the complex

for the public to utilize. (10) Terri Odom addressed the quorum about some questions concerning the comment section, she was told that on 14-14-109 that we had to be sponsored by a justice. Judge Keith apologized if that's the way it came out, 14-14-109 you have to allow citizens to speak on anything that is going to be voted on. Mrs. Odom stated then we don't have to be sponsored to speak and that everyone has 5 minutes for things that are going to be voted on. Judge Keith stated if you wanted to be on the agenda to speak other than what the quorum is fixing to vote on you do have to go to a JP to get a sponsor to be put on the agenda. 



EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 2023-24**

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING A CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE COUNTY OF CRAWFORD, STATE OF ARKANSAS; REVISING, AMENDING, RESTATING, CODIFYING AND COMPILING CERTAIN EXISTING GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION DEALING WITH SUBJECTS EMBRACED IN SUCH CODE OF ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the ordinances of Crawford County, Arkansas, are inadequately classified to such an extent as to render them non-conducive to searches by either County Officials or the general public, and

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code Annotated (A.C.A) § 14-14-903 empowers and authorizes Crawford County, Arkansas, to revise, amend, restate, codify, and compile any existing ordinances and all new ordinances not heretofore adopted or published and to incorporate such ordinances into one unified code in book form; and

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas, has authorized a general compilation, revision, and codification of the ordinances of Crawford County, Arkansas, of a general and permanent nature and the publication of such ordinance in book form: and

WHEREAS, the codification of the ordinances of Crawford County, Arkansas is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation of Crawford County, Arkansas and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Crawford County, Arkansas, that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.

WHEREAS, this code of ordinances for Crawford County has been filed in the County Clerk's Office and available for inspection a minimum of thirty (30) days prior to its adoption as required by A.C.A § 14-14-909

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas:

- 1) The general ordinances of Crawford County, Arkansas, as revised, amended, restated, codified, and compiled in book form are hereby adopted as and shall constitute the "Code of Ordinances of Crawford County, Arkansas."
- 2) Such Code of Ordinances as adopted in Section 1 shall consist of the following Chapters:

- Chapter 1: General Provisions
- Chapter 2: Administration
- Chapter 3: Law Enforcement
- Chapter 4: Taxes
- Chapter 5: Public Records
- Chapter 6: Agriculture and Livestock
- Chapter 7: Animals
- Chapter 8: Community Services
- Chapter 9: Emergency Services
- Chapter 10: Human Services
- Chapter 11: Public Works
- Chapter 12: Roads and Transportation
- Chapter 13: Urban/Rural Development
- Chapter 14: Other County Services

- 3) REPEALER All prior ordinances pertaining to the subjects addressed in this Code of Ordinances are hereby repealed from the effective date of this Ordinance unless they are included and re-ordained, in whole or in part, in this Code; provided, such repeal shall not affect any offense committed or penalty incurred or any right established prior to the effective date of the Ordinance.

Nor shall such repeal affect ordinances which levy taxes, appropriate funds, annex or detach territory, establish franchises, or grant special rights to persons, authorize public improvements, authorize the issuance of bonds, or borrowing of money, authorize the purchase or sale of real or personal property, grant or accept easements, plat or dedication of land to public use, vacate or set the boundaries of streets or other public places. Nor shall such repeal affect any other ordinance of a temporary or special nature or pertaining to subjects not contained in or covered by the Code.

- 4) SPECIFIC REPEALER. By the passage of this Ordinance the following are repealed:

- a. Ord. 1978-017
- b. Ord. 1978-019
- c. Ord. 1979-005
- d. Ord. 1984-011
- e. Ord. 1986-004
- f. Ord. 1987-021
- g. Ord. 1992-003

- 5) Such Code shall be deemed published as of the day of its adoption and approval by the County Judge of Crawford County, Arkansas. The County Clerk of Crawford County, Arkansas is hereby authorized and ordered to file a copy of such Code of Ordinances in the Office of the County Clerk.

- 6) EMERGENCY CLAUSE. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of Crawford County, Arkansas and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.







Crawford County Quorum Court is well aware and apprised of the above-mentioned project and will provide the local portion of the development cost of the entire project.

Therefore, be it resolved, by the Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas that the County Judge is hereby authorized to make application to the Arkansas Department of Parks, Heritage and Tourism for assistance to develop recreational facilities for Crawford County, Arkansas.
