IN THE MATTER OF G.M. BAIL BONDS, LLC

CASE NO. 17CR-21-653

FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

A hearing on the above-referenced matter was held before the Arkansas Professional Bail Bond Company and Professional Bail Bondsman Licensing Board ("Board") on January 12, 2024. Respondent failed to appear for the hearing. The Board was represented by Deputy Attorney General Doralee Chandler. Finding proper notice had been attempted upon Respondent, the Board, from all the evidence presented, makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondents posted an appearance Bond in the criminal matters of *State of Arkansas vs. Juan Escobar*, Crawford County Circuit Court, Case No. 17CR-21-653.
2. Defendant Escobar failed to appear before the Court for either matter after Respondent was served with an Order to Show Cause.
3. On July 19, 2023, a Bond Forfeiture Judgment was entered in the amount of \$25,000.00 for Case No. 17CR-21-653.

4. Respondent failed to pay the Judgment within ninety (90) days; therefore, the Court forwarded the Judgment to the Board.
5. The Board issued a Notice of Hearing and Order to Attend requesting that the Judgment be satisfied by December 11, 2023.
6. Respondent failed to satisfy the Judgment by December 11, 2023, the business is no longer in operation, the Board is unable to locate anyone associated with the company to accept service of documents, and the permit has been revoked.
7. The Respondent's security deposit has been seized by the Board pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §17-19-112 for previous outstanding bond forfeitures and any additional unpaid forfeitures shall be paid from the Bail Bond Recovery Fund.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Respondents failed to comply with the requirements set forth in Ark. Code Ann. §17-19-208(b)(1) to complete payment of a Bond Forfeiture Judgment and Arkansas Rules of Bail Bond Business, Section 30 Unpaid Forfeitures and Misconduct; License Sanctions.
2. Pursuant to the Findings of Fact set out above the Respondents actions are a failure to comply with Ark. Code Ann. §17-19-208, Board Rule 30, and such violations results in a payment to the Court pursuant to Board Rule 44.

ORDER

1. Payment in the amount of \$10,000.00 for Case No. 17CR-21-653 shall be paid by the Board to the Court in compliance with Ark. Code Ann. 17-19-208 and Board Rule 44.
2. Pursuant to the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-212 Respondent may petition for judicial review of this decision by filing a petition in the Circuit

Court in the county in which he resides or does business or in the Circuit Court of Pulaski
County within thirty (30) days after service of this order.

FEBRUARY 20, 2024

The Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas met February 20, 2024, for the second regular meeting of the year. The meeting was held at 7:00 p.m. in the Circuit Courtroom I, 300 Main St., Van Buren, Arkansas. Judge Chris Keith presiding. Gentry Wahlmeier, Prosecuting Attorney legal counsel was present. Roll was called. Members present Justice's Arnold, Atwell, Beauchamp, Carolan, Cox, Martin, Morgan, Myers, Peppas, Shaffer, Wahlmeier, Woodruff with Justice Jennings absent.

The minutes of 1/18/2024 Regular meeting was presented. Justice Peppas moved to approve, second by Justice Morgan and unanimous voice vote to approve as written.

The minutes of the 1/18/2024 Budget Committee meeting was presented. Justice Morgan moved to approve, second by Justice Martin and unanimous voice vote to approve as written.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC:

JUDGES NOTES: (1) Just got word last week we were awarded a 50/50 grant from the Arkansas Parks & Recreation Society \$135,705.00 to build a walking trail around the Diamond Center on Kibler Highway. (2) 9-11 received an email today stating that we have had a setback on some things, hopefully it won't hurt our time line, apparently there was couple of things that fell through the loops that was not ordered. Right now, the switchover is still scheduled for March 21 and 22. Hopefully it will not change but if it does it will probably be June. We don't want to do the change over during the eclipse, if not the only other time would be June for one of our vendors. (3) We are rapping up Division III Courtroom and I was wondering if we could have our March meeting down at Division III so that you can see what we have accomplished. I have talked to Judge Settle, and she would be more than happy for us to come down. (4) Since the last meeting we have had all the rain, flooding and ice we have applied for State Disaster funding. Our state emergency guy has already been here and surveyed the damage. We will get back 35% on that in which it will help us get some funding back. (5) The benefit dinner that Search & Rescue had last week went off with great success and they raised about \$8,000.00 to help upgrade the equipment. (6) The Quorum needs to appoint someone to represent Crawford County at the April 13 Association meeting which will be held in Little Rock, Arkansas. I have spoken to Justice Morgan, and

he said he would be willing to do that if no one else has a nomination. Unanimous voice vote was heard to approve Justice Morgan. (7) Veronica Robbins with the Department of Emergency Management stated that they have had 4 meetings getting prepared for the eclipse. (8) Mrs. Eva White introduced our new Librarian Charlene McDonnough who is now taking over the Library System. Mrs. McDonnough moved here about 1 year ago, and she lives in Fort Smith and has come to our area from South Carolina. Mrs. McDonnough is a retired veteran of the Air Force, she has also taught school in which she has her master's degree in education and her master's degree of Librarian is from the University of South Carolina, she has also worked for 18 years at the library in South Carolina.





FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

A hearing on the above-referenced matter was held before the Arkansas Professional Bail Bond Company and Professional Bail Bondsman Licensing Board ("Board") on January 12, 2024. Respondent failed to appear for the hearing. The Board was represented by Deputy Attorney General Doralee Chandler. Finding proper notice had been attempted upon Respondent, the Board, from all the evidence presented, makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondents posted an appearance Bond in the criminal matters of *State of Arkansas vs. Juan Escobar*, Crawford County Circuit Court, Case No. 17CR-21-653.
2. Defendant Escobar failed to appear before the Court for either matter after Respondent was served with an Order to Show Cause.
3. On July 19, 2023, a Bond Forfeiture Judgment was entered in the amount of \$25,000.00 for Case No. 17CR-21-653.

4. Respondent failed to pay the Judgment within ninety (90) days; therefore, the Court forwarded the Judgment to the Board.
5. The Board issued a Notice of Hearing and Order to Attend requesting that the Judgment be satisfied by December 11, 2023.
6. Respondent failed to satisfy the Judgment by December 11, 2023, the business is no longer in operation, the Board is unable to locate anyone associated with the company to accept service of documents, and the permit has been revoked.
7. The Respondent's security deposit has been seized by the Board pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §17-19-112 for previous outstanding bond forfeitures and any additional unpaid forfeitures shall be paid from the Bail Bond Recovery Fund.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Respondents failed to comply with the requirements set forth in Ark. Code Ann. §17-19-208(b)(1) to complete payment of a Bond Forfeiture Judgment and Arkansas Rules of Bail Bond Business, Section 30 Unpaid Forfeitures and Misconduct; License Sanctions.
2. Pursuant to the Findings of Fact set out above the Respondents actions are a failure to comply with Ark. Code Ann. §17-19-208, Board Rule 30, and such violations results in a payment to the Court pursuant to Board Rule 44.

ORDER

1. Payment in the amount of \$10,000.00 for Case No. 17CR-21-653 shall be paid by the Board to the Court in compliance with Ark. Code Ann. 17-19-208 and Board Rule 44.
2. Pursuant to the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-212 Respondent may petition for judicial review of this decision by filing a petition in the Circuit

Court in the county in which he resides or does business or in the Circuit Court of Pulaski
County within thirty (30) days after service of this order.
