ELECTION COORDINATOR JOB DESCRIPTION

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Voter Registration – this includes but not limited to:
 1. Reviewing voter registration applications for accuracy
 2. Entering new registrants
 3. Making changes to registrants as indicated on applications
 4. Scanning applications and attaching them to the registrant's detail file
 5. Processing the daily DMV report
 6. Processing the felon lists from the Circuit Clerk's office
 7. Removing deceased registrants from list provided by Arkansas Dept of Health
- Preparing packets for candidates filing to run for office.
- Accepting paperwork from candidates/elected officials, processing the paperwork, and maintaining files of each record including but not limited to:
 1. Notice of Candidacy
 2. Political Practices Pledge
 3. Affidavit of Eligibility
 4. Petitions – includes verifying names on petitions
 5. Campaign Financial Reports
 6. Statement of Financial Interest
- Preparing the yearly certification of voters and sending it to the Secretary of State's Offices, deadline is June 1.
- Odd year mailing – in every odd year, prepare the odd-year mailing. This includes but not limited to:
 1. Running the report per the instructions from the Secretary of State office
 2. Printing cards and labels for the mail out
 3. Mailing the cards
 4. Processing and scanning the cards when returned to the County Clerk's office
- Review election calendar and ensure that tasks are completed before the deadline
- Review laws related to the County Clerk's Office concerning election and voter registration
- Recruit election workers and ensure they are trained by the Secretary of State and State Board of Election Commission. Determine the appropriate staff needed for each election. Provide all paperwork for election workers as needed by Payroll Department.
- Order, proof and prepare all materials/ballots pertaining to elections once approved by County Clerk and Election Commissioner
- Perform logic and accuracy testing on all voter equipment with date provided by Election Consultant and provide results to the Secretary of State office
- Proofing data for tablets for each election
- Communicate with designated polling site person to coordinate time to drop off and pick up machines. Will physically deliver and set up election machines
- If needed reserve U-Haul to transport election machines
- Will be present at all CBEC meetings
- Will work with CBEC to set election meetings, dates for ballot draw, opening Provisional etc
- Be available during elections to solve issues and problems as they arise

- Oversee absentee ballot process – preparation and issuance of applications, ballot preparation, etc
- Oversee tabulation and processing of election results; the return of all equipment and supplies
- Will prepare all time sheets, training sign in sheets, oaths for poll workers and election workers and prepare for the Payroll dept in County Clerks office
- The individual is accountable not only to the County Clerk's Office but to the public as a whole. They are accountable to the voters, election workers. Determine deadline dates for candidate reporting and other duties assigned.
- Will be responsible for getting list of all candidates to Secretary of State when needed.
- Will be responsible for the billing of all qualified election expenses with the help of the County Clerk

ELECTION COMMISSIONER RESPONSIBILITIES

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Coordinate with the Election Coordinator and County Clerk with meetings dates and times and to assist in all areas:
 1. Ballot Draw
 2. Logic and Accuracy Testing
 3. Election Night Reporting
 4. Canvass Absentee Ballots
 5. Provisional Ballots
 6. Prepare all minutes for the CBEC and turn into County Clerk
 7. Certification of ALL Elections
 8. Be available to help in any compacity needed to help with the Election Process
- The CBEC is paid \$125.00 per meeting up to ten meetings per Election. If needed can be paid 0-40 hours at \$15.00 an hour per election with approval of the County Clerk.

NOW ON THIS 21st day of September, 2023, comes on for consideration the Motion for Summary Judgment filed by Plaintiff Fire District Number Six of Crawford County, Inc. Defendants have filed their response, and Plaintiff's motion is ripe for consideration. Therefore, the Court being well and sufficiently advised in the law and the premises, ORDERS AND ADJUDGES as follows:

1. That there is no genuine issue of material fact and Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment is GRANTED.
2. That Defendants violated Ark. Code Ann. § 14-284-226 (2019) by failing and refusing to enact an ordinance converting Plaintiff into a fire protection district within sixty days of Plaintiff's written request for such conversion filed with the Crawford County Circuit Clerk on April 24, 2019.
3. That Plaintiff is therefore declared to be a fire protection district within the meaning of Ark. Code Ann. § 14-284-226 (2019) and Ark. Code Ann. § 14-284-

201, *et seq.*, effective as of June 23, 2019, and entitled to all the rights and subject to all to obligations appurtenant thereto.

4. That Plaintiff was damaged by Defendants' violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 14-284-226 (2019) in the total amount of \$221,273.00, and Plaintiff is entitled to and is hereby granted judgment against Defendants in that principal amount, plus prejudgment and post-judgment interest at the maximum rate allowed by law.

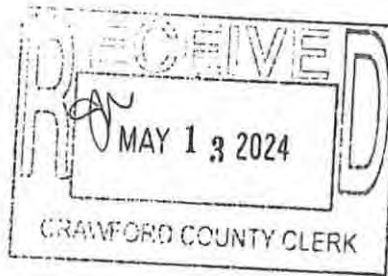



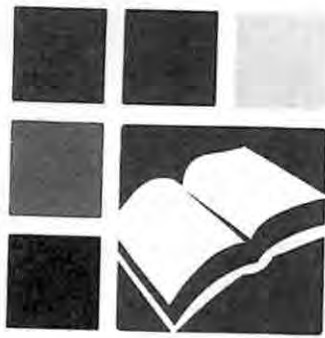

The minutes of 3/11/2024 Regular meeting was presented. Justice Woodruff moved to approve, second by Justice Peppas and unanimous voice vote to approve as written.



ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Voter Registration – this includes but not limited to:
 1. Reviewing voter registration applications for accuracy
 2. Entering new registrants
 3. Making changes to registrants as indicated on applications
 4. Scanning applications and attaching them to the registrant's detail file
 5. Processing the daily DMV report
 6. Processing the felon lists from the Circuit Clerk's office
 7. Removing deceased registrants from list provided by Arkansas Dept of Health
- Preparing packets for candidates filing to run for office.
- Accepting paperwork from candidates/elected officials, processing the paperwork, and maintaining files of each record including but not limited to:
 1. Notice of Candidacy
 2. Political Practices Pledge
 3. Affidavit of Eligibility
 4. Petitions – includes verifying names on petitions
 5. Campaign Financial Reports
 6. Statement of Financial Interest
- Preparing the yearly certification of voters and sending it to the Secretary of State's Offices, deadline is June 1.
- Odd year mailing – in every odd year, prepare the odd-year mailing. This includes but not limited to:
 1. Running the report per the instructions from the Secretary of State office
 2. Printing cards and labels for the mail out
 3. Mailing the cards
 4. Processing and scanning the cards when returned to the County Clerk's office
- Review election calendar and ensure that tasks are completed before the deadline
- Review laws related to the County Clerk's Office concerning election and voter registration
