





F POD FAN BLADE ISSUE During work on E pod unit heard the condenser fans on f pod unit to be noisy and upon investigation found both blades cracked. Called supplier for price and availability and was told one was in stock, one would be in next week. Got approval to pick the one up to prevent unit from becoming inoperable. Picked the blade up, pulled the one that was in worse shape and replaced with new. Tightened set bolt and replaced guard, verified unit went back to normal operation. Will return to replace second one when it arrives. Picked up the second fan blade for unit, took it and tools required for replacement to roof. Removed guard, cleaned motor shaft and removed cracked fan blade. Installed new blade and verified tightness of set screw and depth of blade are correct. Secured motor plug to motor while in unit, replaced guard, and powered unit on. Verified fan blade had clearance and unit went to normal operation. Complete.

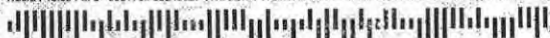

QUORUM COURT JOURNAL OF PROCEDURES

August 19, 2024

The Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas met August 19, 2024, for the eighth regular meeting of the year. The meeting was held at 7:00 p.m. in Circuit Courtroom I, 300 Main Street, Van Buren, AR. Judge Chris Keith presiding. Gentry Wahlmeier, the Prosecuting Attorney office legal counsel was present. Roll call was called. Members present: Justices Arnold, Atwell, Beauchamp, Carolan, Cox, Jennings, Martin, Morgan, Myers, Peppas, Shaffer, Wahlmeier, Woodruff.

The minutes of 7/15/2024 Budget meeting was presented. Justice Woodruff moved to approve, second by Justice Morgan a unanimous voice vote to approve as written.

The minutes of the 7/15/2024 Regular meeting was presented. Justice Morgan moved to approve, second by Justice Atwell a unanimous voice vote to approve as written.

REPORTS: Justice Morgan moved to accept reports presented, second by Justice Myers a unanimous voice vote to approve as submitted.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: Judge Keith handed out an update on the port. We are still in the environmental study phase. We have been into that study for about a year and a half and in hopes of it being complete within the next six months. That study must be complete before we can move forward with the grants, we have received on this. We have put out for Engineers which we should have a finalized Engineer by September/October to start doing the final design. Construction cannot start until we have the final design and approved through both sources. We are looking at the next 3 to 5 years for the construction to be complete on this project. It is on hold until that study is completed. We are waiting for a report back from EDA on the final study before we can proceed forward.
Before next month's Quorum Court meeting the ARPA committee will be meeting.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC: Judge Keith asked for comments from the public on Ordinances being voted on this evening. Chief of Police from Alma, Jeff Pointer introduced himself and wanted to speak on the Ordinance presented by Sheriff Daniel Perry to increase fee charged to the municipalities for housing prisoners in the County Jail. At the current time municipalities are paying the rate of \$40.00 per day per inmate to house each inmate. The increase would be about a 37 % increase from the \$40.00 per day to \$55.00 per day. The cities already struggle with the amount already set in place, increasing the fee by that amount would put a financial burden on the cities. Any ticket we write, whether taking them to jail or not, there is a \$20.00 fee that is collected and sent to the county, whether they are found guilty, not guilty or no contest that \$20.00 fee is collected. From January until the end of July that \$20.00 fee was just under \$14,000.00 and we paid almost \$38,000.00 in jail fees. On top of that for all felonies and Class A misdemeanors there is another \$40.00 fee that is collected and sent to the County and 90% of that fee is retained by the County to be used for the jail. A \$15.00 increase in the middle of a budget year is a big increase to their budget. If we book someone in the jail on a warrant and they also have a warrant from another city, then both cities are charged fees. If we take someone to jail at 10:00 p.m. and they are there until 2:00 a.m. we are charged for 2 days. Chief Pointer asked the Quorum Court to think about all of this before they make any decisions on any increase for the municipalities.
Chief Shannon Gregory from the Mulberry police department, there isn't a whole lot he could add to Chief Pointers presentation, except Mulberry's budget isn't as big as Alma's budget, but wanted to give

some numbers. This year Mulberry has paid \$6,360.00 which is 159 days paid to the County. If we added on another \$15.00 per day that would increase an additional \$2,385.00 for a total of \$8,745.00, which may not sound like a lot, but for the City of Mulberry that is huge. This year we started contributing to the 911 center, which is something new for us. We lost \$80,000.00 in tax revenue for this year. I have four officers. If we would've had any more set back, I would have had to lay off two of my officers. For the smaller departments adding an extra \$15.00 a day to jail fees would be detrimental to us. Chief Gregory stated he would be glad to have a tabletop discussion and work together to come up with something that would help everyone.

Chief Kirby Smith from the Kibler police department agrees with what the previous two chiefs have said. We have a two-man department, small population and a small budget that about 50% of the budget is for the officers' salaries. We have paid \$4,200.00 in jail fees so far this year. Adding an additional \$15.00 per day would add \$1,575.00 on top of what we have already paid in. We are also paying for dispatch, which has never been in our budget before, and trying to buy new equipment and we have other costs going up as well. Any kind of increase will absolutely hurt Kibler police department.

Sheriff Daniel Perry states he can't argue with anything the Chiefs have said and he agrees with them. The problem is how do you cover a \$6,000.00 increase on your water bill. I have asked the water company to come out and replace the meter. They were going to send someone out the following day to test the meter. He has reached out to other Sheriff's throughout the state. The state average daily is \$64.27 per day on housing inmates and that's from 3, 4 and 5 class counties. Sebastian County is \$66.00 a day. The sheriff stated that maybe the water department will come and check everything and say we have been paying too much since the jail was built and we get free water from now on. Also stated that he would just like to table the ordinance. The Sheriff stated that the increase of \$15.00 a day would pay the increase in the water bill each month and nothing extra.

Justice Morgan asked if there was anyway, he could look through his accounts to cover the increase of the water bill until the end of the year and then we can look at a possible increase at that time, where the city's would be able to build it into their budgets for next year. That way their budgets would be able to absorb the increase.

Sheriff Perry stated maybe, and his medical increased, after changing company's. The medical is going up \$72,000.00 this year. I'm going to have to eat that with what extra money I do have. I can't cut down medical on inmates. I would be glad to sit down with everyone and talk about everything. Justice Woodruff asked the question if this water bill was just this month or has it been that way for several months. Sheriff Perry stated that April usage was more usage than this water bill with the increase of \$6,000.00, this is just increase due to Fort Smith water rates increasing.

Attorney Gentry Wahlmeier stated we are past our 5-minute public comment time, and we need to get back to new business.

JUDGES NOTES: (1) Several storms over the weekend that the crews have been out on working roads, power lines are down. Wanted to thank all involved in working on getting everything cleaned up. We have done verbal and written declaration to Arkansas Department of Emergency Management Disaster. The threshold on damages is a little less than \$277,000.00 and if we meet that threshold, we will get 35% of our money back. If the threshold is 6.2 million with all Arkansas county's combined, then it will turn into a federal disaster and we could get 75% of our money back.

After the motion was made to table Justice Woodruff wanted to discuss the ordinance. Attorney Gentry Wahlmeier stated that to discuss they needed a motion to put it back on the floor for discussion. Justice Atwell asked if we could have it up for discussion after its tabled. Attorney Wahlmeier said no due to it already being tabled. Justice Peppas asked what do we need to do to get it going to do a study session on this. Attorney Gentry stated you could discuss it as soon as Justice Woodruff withdraws her motion. Justice Woodruff withdrew her motion. Justice Atwell stated that he agreed with Justice Morgan and that us as a committee do not like it when our budget changes in the middle of a year. Justice Atwell asked Treasurer Daniel Watson about some funds that have been there for a couple of years and asked can we use that to cover the excess expenses on the water bill. Treasurer Watson stated that we do have the Fund #3427 which is the ½ cent sales tax that we could use to help with the extra expenses. Justice Atwell recommended that we look at it to just automatically increase a certain percentage each year that way the cities can go ahead and build it in their budget. Justice Beauchamp stated that he would love to see him get with a professional to look at our water consumption and find some creative ways for us to save on water usage. He stated I can't fathom the amount of water being used. We should be investing money to figure out what we can do to make it more efficient. We need to figure out a way to get ahead of that instead of trying to figure out a way to spend more money. Justice Beauchamp asked Judge Keith if we could have an in-depth study session. He asked Sheriff Perry how much it costs to house a prisoner for a day, Sheriff Perry replied its around \$80.00 a day. Sheriff Perry stated he has had plumbers and leak detectors to come out and there hasn't been a leak or any other issue that anyone could find. He stated we are doing everything the way other counties are doing. Justice Carolan pulled water bills to research and raised the question with the Sheriff that the water bills for the jail had been paid out of the Jail & Law Enforcement Fund and the one water bill that's in question was paid out of Public Safety Fund. He asked if that was correct or just a clerical error. Judge Keith had stated that according to the auditor the only water bill to be paid out of Public Safety was the gun range water bill. Judge Keith asked County Clerk Stacey Shelly if that was correct, and she agreed. Judge Keith asked Sheriff Perry, and he stated it was a clerical error. It can be rectified with a Court Order to have funds put back into Public Safety. Justice Woodruff made the motion to table Ordinance 2024-17, second by Justice Atwell. Roll Call 13 yeas. Ordinance is tabled.




