





E-POD CIRCUIT 1 FLAT. While checking computer for hvac issues I noticed E pod suction transducer not reading correctly. I went to unit to verify pressure with gauges and found circuit 1 flat. Pressurized and checked for leaks, found discharge pressure transducer leaking. Replaced with new one, also replaced filter drier as a precaution since it is unknown how long system has been flat. Pressurized system after replacing filter drier and transducer. Checked for leaks, evacuated circuit. Will let vacuum run overnight to remove all moisture possible before charging system. Checked vacuum, charged circuit with refrigerant, started unit, checked operation. Suction pressure transducer is not reading correctly, will need to replace. Ordered transducer. Picked up new transducers. Replaced suction pressure transducer. Verified operation through control system. Checked for leaks with soap bubbles. Unit is now operating correctly.







STUDY SESSION

TO: Crawford County Quorum Court, Elected Officials, News Media, City Chief of Police and City Mayors

Monday, October 28, 2024, at 6:00 PM, in the Circuit Courtroom Division I, 300 Main Street, upstairs in the Courthouse, Van Buren, Arkansas.

MINUTES

Study session called to order by Judge Keith at 6:00 p.m. Budget Chairman asked Sheriff Perry to come and start discussion on a rate increase for the jail inmates from the Municipalities. Sheriff stated that starting in September that the jail water bill went up 37%. He stated the usage has not changed since the building was built. It has fluctuated here and there, but for the most part has stayed the same. Had several engineers, rural water, 71 water, different plumbers and nobody could find any leaks through the walk through. They are looking for grants to maybe help with the purchase of timers for the showers.

Sheriff stated his proposal was to raise the rates. They haven't been raised since 2018 and water is not the only thing that has gone up. Medical contract has gone up approximately \$150,000.00. When an inmate goes to the hospital the County has to pick up the bill vs when the state inmate goes, the jail is reimbursed.

Justice Beauchamp stated with the increasing costs of everything involved, his suggestion would be to revisit yearly. Sheriff stated Legislation passed that mandated water rates go up to cover for the water companies increases. Justice Carolan asked about the approximate amount it cost was roughly \$65.00 a day to hold an inmate, but we are only asking for \$60.00 a day to hold the federal inmates, but Washington County gets \$80.00 a day for federal inmates. Sebastian County gets \$70.00 a day. Why are we willing to take less than them? Captain Winters explained the offset of what it costs to hold federal inmate vs county/state inmates and he explained why the other counties were coming in at the higher rate. They have been in the federal inmate program for some time now and they started out at a lower rate and it has increased. Justice Carolan suggested trying to negotiate with the federal marshals again to possibly get a higher daily rate.

Justice Peppas asked if maybe getting with the attorney to see if we could do an Ordinance stating that we would not take less than \$65.00 a day per federal inmate. Sheriff Perry stated he would check into that.

Mulberry Chief Shannon Gregory, concerned with the increase of water would bring an increase to the cities and they would be paying more than the feds, and how would that be right? You would be charging your cities more than the feds for the inmates to stay in jail. Sheriff Perry stated the state will still be \$40.00 a day.

Justice Woodruff asked about prorating the fee. Sheriff Perry stated we could look into that. Chief Gregory is concerned with an inmate with warrants with the different cities

and they are all charged the same rate per day, Chief Gregory stated we aren't against you we just want to be able to work together.

Justice Beauchamp asked what a compromise would be for the cities? Kibler Chief Smith stated that he called around to the other Class 5 counties and the highest that they pay for an inmate is \$42 a day. He called around different surroundings counties and state inmates are \$40.00 a day, but the average for the smaller counties around our size was approximately \$42 to \$43 a day. Sheriff Perry asked Chief Smith if the other counties say how they were funded, he stated he did not ask how they were funded. He didn't ask if they were tax funded or if they had federal inmates. Captain Winters stated that the daily jail fees varies throughout the state.

Sheriff Perry stated that we have not had an increase since 2018 and asked if we should never increase it and stated that the budget was going through the roof. Chief Kirby stated that the smaller cities were also feeling the increase in their budgets with everything going up in price. Alma Chief Pointer stated that we are not against the Sheriff or the County Sheriff's office, stated that they are not opposed to an increase, and they are experiencing everything going up as well. The jail fees that the cities pay is not the only place the jail gets funding. Every ticket that the cities write a \$20.00 fee is collected on each one of those tickets whether guilty or not guilty and that fee goes straight to the county. When you are talking about the 37% increase that's a big increase to the cities budget as well. County has the ¼ cent sales tax that goes straight to the jail and a portion of the Public Safety tax goes to the jail. Alma has paid roughly \$48,000.00 from January to September of this year and to add a \$15.00 increase per day is money we would have to find where that money would come from. Chief Pointer stated they don't have anywhere to turn to raise their fees to collect more money.

Justice Peppas asked if there was a way to come up with an idea of possibly passing an ordinance on whomever walks the inmate into the jail pays the fees instead of possibly 3 different cities, costing \$120.00 a day, due to the inmate having a warrant from each city. Justice Peppas asked why the cities are being charged \$40.00 a day when it only costs \$40.00 a day per inmate. Sheriff Perry stated we could look at that and see.

Justice Carolan asked about a possible increase of \$5.00 per day and to revisit it again next year and see where we stand. The Chiefs are not opposed to a \$5.00 increase as long as they have gotten approval from their City Mayors.

Mayor Wilson asked if the jail fees were put in County General and then dispersed into other funds for the county jail. It was made known that the money in County General would only cover the salaries and benefits of the Sheriff's office employees in that fund. Lengthy discussion was had by JP's and Chiefs on different ideas. There was a discussion on levelized billing and revisiting it yearly. There was a discussion on flat rate increase or possible percentage increase.

Judge Keith asked if it would be easier to move a couple of the employees from the ¼ cent sales tax to the County General fund. County Clerk Stacey Shelly stated that with just moving one employee from ¼ cent to County General would free up approximately \$60,000.00 a year for the increase in water bill for the ¼ cent fund.

Discussion ended with the proposal of doing an Ordinance for the next QC meeting increasing the jail fee by \$5.00 with moving one employee from ¼ cent to County General and revisiting at the end of the next year or have another study to see where we stand.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2018-28 TO INCREASE THE DAILY FEE CHARGED TO MUNICIPALITIES FOR HOUSING PRISONERS IN THE COUNTY JAIL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Crawford County Sheriff charges a daily fee to house prisoners and that fee is set by the Quorum Court; and

WHEREAS, the fee was last set in 2018 and the cost of housing prisoners has increased substantially.

SECTION 1. That the \$40.00 per day charge currently charged to municipalities for housing prisoners in the County Jail found in Ordinance 2018-28 Section 1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Each municipality and/or state prisoner housed in the County Jail shall pay a daily fee of \$45.00 (or with regard to state prisoners, the maximum amount otherwise allowed by law) for each day the prisoner is incarcerated for the housing, feeding, and caring for the prisoner."

SECTION 2. That each \$45.00 daily fee collected shall be paid to Fund #1000 County General.

SECTION 3. That this amendment will go into effect on January 1, 2025.

SECTION 4. That the Quorum Court finds the facts set out herein to be true and correct.
