QUORUM COURT JOURNAL OF PROCEDURES

November 18, 2024

The Quorum Court of Crawford County, Arkansas met November 18, 2024, for the eleventh regular meeting of the year. The meeting was held at 7:00 p.m. in Circuit Courtroom I, 300 Main Street, Van Buren, AR. Judge Chris Keith presiding. Gentry Wahlmeier, the Prosecuting Attorney office legal counsel was present. Roll call was called. Members present: Justices Arnold, Atwell, Beauchamp, Carolan, Cox, Jennings, Martin, Morgan, Myers, Peppas, Shaffer, Woodruff.

The minutes of 10/21/2024 Budget meeting was presented. Justice Morgan moved to approve, second by Justice Arnold a unanimous voice vote to approve as written.

The minutes of 10/28/2024 Study Session was presented. Justice Morgan moved to approve, second by Justice Arnold a unanimous voice vote to approve as written.

The minutes of the 10/21/2024 Regular meeting was presented. Justice Peppas moved to approve, second by Justice Morgan a unanimous voice vote to approve as written.

REPORTS: Justice Woodruff moved to accept reports presented, reports added per auditor request were Court Orders CC 2024-36, CC 2024-37 and CC 2024-44 Disposing or Donating of County Property second by Justice Morgan a unanimous voice vote to approve as submitted.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: Budget Chairman, Mark Shaffer announced that we have received final numbers on insurance today and we will be getting those numbers together in the next couple of days and we will be setting up meeting times.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC:

JUDGES NOTES: (1) Judge Keith wanted to congratulate all those that were elected or re-elected in the Election on November 5th and also wanted to thank everyone that was willing to serve their community and County. Reminder to everyone that was elected to get with the County Clerk to pay their \$5.00 fee for their Oath of Office that needs to be turned in by December 2nd. (2) The Courthouse lighting will be Saturday, December 7th and 6:00 p.m. (3) We got our health insurance numbers in and we are working on the final numbers for budget. (4) Road Department just finished up chip in seal. The guys stayed late on Friday night to finish up. (5) Judge Keith asked the Quorum Court to consider letting the employees have off December 23nd, with the County buildings being closed on Tuesday the 24th and Wednesday the 25th, Justice Atwell made the motion to close County Buildings and give employees the 23nd off as well as the 24th and 25th, second by Justice Woodruff. Unanimous voice vote to approve the extra day off.

CALL FOR OLD BUSINESS:

CALL FOR NEW BUSINESS:

 RESOLUTION NO. 2024-04 BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF CRAWFORD, STATE OF ARKANSAS, A RESOLUTION TO BE ENTITLED: A RESOLUTION OF THE CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS QUORUM COURT TO ADOPT A CONTRACT TO HOUSE FEDERAL

INMATES. Justice Shaffer motion to put on the floor by title only, Justice Morgan second. Justice Myers made motion to approve and Justice Woodruff second. Justice Shaffer asked what the rate on this was due to it not being listed in the Resolution. Captain Winters stated the rate is \$60.00 per day per inmate, plus \$22.00 an hour reimbursement for transport. Justice Shaffer asked why that was less than other counties? Captain Winters stated that other counties have already had federal inmates and can renegotiate every six months. Justice Peppas stated that he had spoken with someone local in the business and he stated that it is always low when starting out until the county gets established and then will go up. Stated that this would be a test run. Justice Cox asked how long a test run would be. Captain Winters stated this would be for 36 months, before they could renegotiate. Captain Winters also stated that this is not to make money its to fund positions. that the jail needs. Stated they are 10 to 12 short according to state. The money that would be coming in could possibly be over \$400,000.00 if had federal inmates for 365 days with 25 inmates and the positions that they would be asking for would be approximately \$360,000.00. You have to have two certified officers to transport federal inmates. Justice Beauchamp asked if they tried to renegotiate after our study session and Captain Winters stated yes and they are not going up any higher. They would only be asking for 2 new employees at the moment. We don't receive any money on County inmates. Captain Winters stated they were negotiating with the Chicago headquarters not anyone locally. The only thing that has been done locally was the marshals who inspected the jail. Roll call 5 yeas, 6 no, 1 absent, 1 abstain. Ordinance failed.

SECTION 2. All collections by the Crawford County Circuit Clerk made before this Ordinance are hereby ratified as appropriate and the authorization and consent of the Quorum Court.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, it shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined by the Quorum Court that collections of fees as a TSA Pre-Check. TWIC, and Hazmat Acceptance Facility is an immediate and ongoing responsibility which must be addressed for the benefit and welfare of the County; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval

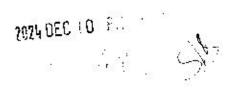

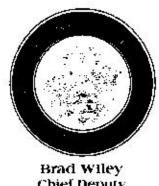

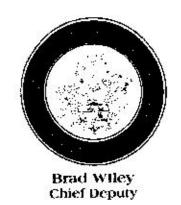

SECTION 1. ANNUAL BUDGET ADOPTED BY REFERENCE

SECTION 5. For the purpose of this ordinance and to maintain the fiscal integrity of the County, funding of appropriation contained herein is dependent upon the availability of adequate revenues. The Quorum Court reserves unto itself the right to impose constraints or restrictions upon the expenditure of funds within the measure should the necessity arise.

SECTION 6. Each item appropriated for salaries herein is the annual salary or compensation for the position. Unless otherwise specified in this ordinance, annual salary or compensation is bi-weekly one week after accrual. If payday fails on a holiday, checks will be issued on the last working day of the week. In the event of vacancy for any period of times in any position or positions set out herein provided for such position or positions shall be proportionally reduced.

SECTION 7. Attachments "A" "B", "C", "D' "E" "F" "G", "H' are the detailed budget requests from each requesting party and show in detail by line item, the purpose or use for the funds requested and the amount appropriated

These documents are on file in the County Clerk's office and may be examined by any member of the public

SECTION 8. The 2025 Anticipated Revenue for all funds is set forth in Attachment "H" which is nereby incorporated by reference

SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.
