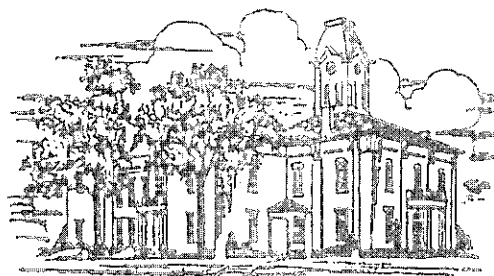

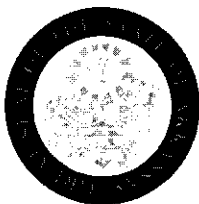

AGREED ORDER ON BOND FORFEITURE

NOW ON THIS DAY this matter comes on for Agreed Order on issue of the bail bond deposited in lieu of bail to be forfeited to Crawford County. The State of Arkansas is represented by Will Cosner, Campbell Bail Bonding by and through Jim Campbell, The Defendant having failed to appear in this matter since June 25, 2025, the Court, the Court does hereby find:

I

That the Defendant Matthew Jaime Acosta was arrested on January 5, 2025, for the charges of Residential Burglary a Class "B" Felony, Criminal Mischief-First Degree \$1000 to \$5000 in damage a Class "D" Felony, Domestic Battery- Third Degree a Class "A" Misdemeanor, and Assault- Third Degree a Class "C" Misdemeanor. This arrest stemmed from a warrant which was filed on June 27<sup>th</sup> 2022, in Warrant No. 17CI-22-424.

II.

The warrant was served on January 5, 2025 upon the Defendant Jaime Acosta. A Bail Bond was executed on January 5, 2025 with Campbell Bail Bonding Company, Inc. Signed by Tieler Goff, Agent with Campbell Bonding, as well as Jim Campbell, President of Campbell Bonding, and the Defendant Jaime Acosta, which outlined that if the Defendant failed to appear and at all times render himself amenable to the orders of the court in prosecution of charges, that Campbell Bonding would pay the sum of \$25,000. At that time the Defendants address was listed as 2607 High Street in Fort Smith, AR.




That the Defendant failed to appear for a status hearing before the Honorable Judge Marc McCune on June 25, 2025. A warrant was issued on July 2, 2025. Since that time the State of Arkansas was informed that the Defendant has returned to his country of origin which is El Salvador. Campbell Bonding has presented proof of an agent traveling to El Salvador to attempt recovery of the Defendant; however, the efforts have been unsuccessful. There being no reason why the Defendant continues to fail to appear for court the Court orders that Campbell Bail Bonds shall forfeit the sum of \$12,500 for the Defendants failure to appear in 17CR-25-28.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED, that **Campbell Bail Bonds, Inc.** Forfeit the amount of \$12,500.00 to the Crawford County Circuit Clerks, Office within thirty (30) days.

Chairman Justice Brad Martin called the Technology Committee meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. for discussion on directing a study and development of virtual meeting capabilities for quorum court and committee meetings. Justice Martin asked Justice Bell to recap on what he was wanting to see happen. Justice Bell wanted to discuss the Resolution 2026-01 that was presented at the January QC meeting. Justice Bell stated that the Arkansas House Bill 1879 that was wanting to mandate video recordings failed to pass in the 2025 Regular Session. Justice Bell presented a handout on Other Counties Live Now that had several counties that live stream their meetings. Justice Martin asked are these live streaming in the sense of the public can view it and log in and view it. Justice Martin ask isn't it illegal for someone to remote in to an in person meeting. Justice Bell stated that it wouldn't be illegal in a state of emergency. Bell stated that as of right now we are under a state of emergency and would be allowed to remote in. He stated we were in a state of emergency for 30 days due to the snowstorm. Different discussions were had on the different platforms that could be used for live streaming the QC meetings. County IT, Grayson Pyle, was present to offer the different avenues we could take on having live streamed meetings. Justice Bell stated that he spoke with Veronica Robins on possibly getting a grant to help with this project. Judge Keith stated he would find out what he could from the other County Judges at the Judges conference. Suggestion was to check into funding and capabilities and start testing measures to start live streaming our meetings. Agreed upon giving our IT enough time to get everything together and will report back to the committee.

### MINUTES

Meeting called to order by Chair Justice Woodruff at 6:00 p.m. Brought to the floor for discussion Ordinance 2026-02 which is the noise ordinance. Justice Peppas stated that he was against the ordinance due to that being one of the perks of living in the County. Justice Stinchcomb asked Sheriff Perry how many times have you had to go out there and told someone that they are being excessively loud and then actually fighting it. Sheriff Perry stated that he believes that there may be other laws out there, state laws, that could be more appropriate to use instead of an ordinance. There are a lot of different factors that would need to be considered when trying to determine if the noise was too loud. Judge Keith stated that he brought the ordinance for discussion due to getting phone calls of loud music going late at night. One example was New Years Eve with loud music going til 6:00 a.m. Mike Jones was present to speak about the noise in that area. He presented letters from neighbors to back up his complaint on the noise issue. He stated that him and several other neighbors have called in and made complaints and were told from the Sheriff's office that if they kept calling they would be arrested. Sheriff Perry stated that he was not aware of that. Discussion went on with Mr. Jones. Justice Bell asked Prosecutor Kevin Holmes to explain other remedies that might could happen. Mr. Holmes explained that you could file for a private nuisance or how a public nuisance could be filed. With the ordinance it does not have the power to make it stop like a court order from a Judge could. Justice Bell asked if there was anything the county could do. Mr. Holmes stated the best avenue would be the civil suit. Justice Woodruff stated we want to help get something done for the citizens, but the way to go now might be a civil suit. The event center, Luna, was represented by their Attorney Dalton Person. Mr. Person stated they do have rules and policies for every renter when they rent this establishment that they have to abide by. Judge Keith stated that the owners are moving towards making changes for a remedy in the situation.

Discussion on Ordinance 2026-03, Justice Bell wanted to discuss the process of committee meetings. Justice Woodruff stated that we have not always had something to come up to warrant a committee meeting, there is not always a topic to have to take to committee, but when there is we take it to a committee. Justice Bell asked if there was not 4 budget committee meetings a year. Justice Woodruff and Justice Shaffer both stated that there is a budget meeting before every QC meeting. Justice Bell stated he doesn't like the way it is being handled now. Explained that he doesn't see where there is enough time from when they get the packets til the meeting. He stated he would like to be at the meeting to discuss before it is put on paper before taken to the QC meeting. Justice Shaffer stated we do have time for discussion on each appropriation in the budget meeting. Justice Stinchcomb asked if we could not get our package earlier than what we are doing now, that way we have time to go through the stuff in the packets.

Justice Peppas asked if we could just have so many on a committee instead of everyone being on all. Judge Keith stated that we have tried both ways and have received complaints both ways. Judge Keith mentioned that some of the ones complaining about not getting enough time are the ones that doesn't pick up their packets til Monday night. Justice Bell stated that the JP's can't talk to each other. Clerk Stacey Shelly reminded him that yes the JP's can speak with one another. It was changed in legislation. Prosecutor Holmes stated he thinks it wouldn't be wise to call another JP and try to sway their vote. He suggested that we break up the JP's into the committees. Justice Peppas asked if they have a committee meeting do they have to burden the clerk with the meetings. Prosecutor Holmes stated no that it would be up to the chair of the committee. Clerk Shelly stated that she does have to be at every committee meeting. She has to get all the paperwork together and make sure it gets sent. Mr. Holmes asked Ms. Shelly if she has to be at every meeting, she stated yes she has to attend every meeting. Asked about how we are letting the public notice of the meetings. Ms. Shelly stated that the information is put on the website for the public notification. Discussion on budget meetings for 2025. Discussion on the time frame on receiving their packets. Concerned with not getting enough information on things for the budget meetings. Ms. Shelly stated that from here on out a deadline is a deadline and they will be followed from here on out. Ms. Shelly suggested that we could start meeting on the QC deadline day at 6:00 p.m. to discuss the budget ahead of time. She stated that would be 2 Mondays in a row, and asked are you going to do that, due to how many JP's showed up for tonight's meeting. That has always been a big part of all our committee meetings. Justice Stinchcomb asked if there was a way of getting the letters ahead of time. Ms. Shelly stated she could email the letters out to them after the deadline to give them enough time to go over and get their questions answered. Discussion on how packets were received. Judge Keith asked if there was anything on the Ordinance that needed to be changed. Judge Keith presented an idea of having a study session every QC night at 6:00 p.m. The JP's present were ok with this idea.







**CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS  
ORDINANCE NO. 2026-02**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:**

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING UNREASONABLY LOUD MUSIC THAT DISTURBS THE PEACE IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, Crawford County has no provision at law to enforce disturbances of the peace associated with unreasonably loud music within its unincorporated areas;

**WHEREAS**, unreasonably loud and disturbing music of such volume or duration as to be detrimental to the life or health of the individual is a nuisance and legislation against it is essential to the public health and safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of this Ordinance is immediately necessary for preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of Crawford County, Arkansas, and an emergency exists which requires that this Ordinance become immediately effective and of full force and effect, immediately.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** It shall be unlawful for any person to play any radio, stereo, music reproduction system, or musical instrument in such a manner or at such volume as to disturb the peace and quiet of neighbors or nearby residents, between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, and between 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Friday and Saturday.

**SECTION 2.** Any violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500). The Crawford County Sheriff's Department shall enforce this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance covers only those areas of Crawford County which are unincorporated.

**SECTION 4.** The Quorum Court hereby finds and declares that the facts set out herein are true and correct. This Ordinance shall be codified in the Crawford County Code of Ordinances and the sections therein may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish this intention.

**SECTION 5.** The various paragraphs hereof and portions hereof being severable, should any part thereof be declared invalid, for any reason, the remainder hereof shall continue in full force and effect.

**SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE:** the peace of our citizens is essential to the public health, safety, and welfare of Crawford County, and the goal can be met by enactment of this ordinance; an emergency is therefore, declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF CRAWFORD, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES FOR QUORUM COURT COMMITTEE MEETINGS TO PROMOTE TRANSPARENCY AND PARTICIPATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Quorum Court of Crawford County may establish committees to assist in its legislative duties, including the review and recommendation of budgetary matters, pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-14-904; and

**WHEREAS**, all committee meetings must be open to the public and comply with the Arkansas Freedom of Information Act (ACA § 25-19-101 et seq.) and other applicable laws to ensure transparency and accountability; and

**WHEREAS**, defining the requirements for a legal committee meeting and mandating regular and accessible meetings will encourage participation by all Quorum Court members, foster informed decision-making, and better serve the residents of Crawford County; and

**WHEREAS**, several members of the Quorum Court have expressed interest in active involvement in committee processes, particularly for budget-related matters, and establishing clear rules will address current limitations in meeting frequency and inclusivity.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** Definition of a Legal Committee Meeting. A legal meeting of any standing or special committee of the Quorum Court shall constitute a gathering that meets the following requirements: • It is open to the public in accordance with the Arkansas Freedom of Information Act. • Notice of the meeting, including time, place, and agenda, is provided to all committee members, the full Quorum Court, and the public at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance, or forty-eight (48) hours if the meeting involves budgetary appropriations. • A quorum, consisting of a majority of the committee's appointed members, is present. • Written minutes are recorded, including attendance, discussions, and any recommendations or actions taken, and such minutes shall be made available to the public and filed with the County Clerk within five (5) business days. • The meeting complies with all other applicable state laws, including provisions for virtual or hybrid formats if adopted by the Quorum Court.

**SECTION 2.** Requirement for Regular Meetings. The Budget Committee shall hold regular meetings at least once per calendar quarter, or more frequently as determined by

the committee chair or by ordinance. All other standing committees of the Quorum Court shall hold regular meetings at least once per calendar year. The chair of each standing committee shall schedule and announce these meetings in compliance with Section 1.

**SECTION 3. Meetings Upon Request.** Upon written request by at least three (3) members of the Quorum Court (who may or may not be committee members), the committee chair shall call and schedule a meeting within ten (10) business days of receiving the request. The request must specify the purpose and proposed agenda items. If the chair fails to schedule the meeting, the County Judge shall appoint an acting chair to convene it.

**SECTION 4. Applicability.** These rules shall apply to all Quorum Court committees, with priority given to ensuring broad participation in budget-related discussions and decisions.

**SECTION 5.** The Quorum Court hereby finds and declares that the facts set out herein are true and correct.

**SECTION 6.** The various paragraphs hereof and portions hereof being severable, should any part thereof be declared invalid, for any reason, the remainder hereof shall continue in full force and effect.
