Judge Chris Keith presiding. Kevin Holmes, the Prosecuting Attorney office legal counsel, was present. Roll call was called. Members present: Justices Arnold, Bell, Cox, Johnson, Morgan, Myers, Peppas, Shaffer, Staton, Stinchcomb.

The minutes of the 2/17/2026 Regular meeting minutes were presented. Justice Peppas moved to approve, second by Justice Morgan, a unanimous voice vote to approve as written.

The minutes of the 2/13/2026 Technology committee meeting and the 3/5/2026 Health & Welfare Committee meeting. Justice Morgan moved to approve, second by Justice Stinchcomb, a unanimous voice vote to approve as written.

If anyone interested we can set up a tour of the hospital. Its only being used as an ER. Justice Peppas suggested making it a training hospital. Judge Keith will look into dates for a possible tour. To lose this lease would be a hit to our County General fund.

JUDGES NOTES: (1) Our Road Dept has been working on pot holes, because we will be done with asphalt for the year. We will be widening Dean Rd and overlaying. Finish connecting Freedom Valley Rd to Ball Road. Hard surface 2 miles Kimes Road. We have a few culvert situations to take care of. (2) Legislative audit – went well. We had one finding for 2024 – lease dump trucks ran through HGHC which is a buying source where you don't have to bid it. They did not run the one we bought through HGHC and we did not bid it. That was a finding on our audit. This was an oversight and will not happen again. Everything else went well. Justice Bell asked if we had any bonded debt, Judge Keith stated no we do not. 



ORDINANCE NO. 2026-11**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE FOR AN ADOPT-A-MILE CLEANUP PROGRAM OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Crawford County has no provision at law to incentivize community involvement in maintaining the cleanliness and sanitary nature of county roads;

WHEREAS, a voluntary program where persons can agree to clean designated sections of county roads is solely beneficial to the community; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Ordinance is immediately necessary for preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of Crawford County, Arkansas, and an emergency exists which requires that this Ordinance become immediately effective and of full force and effect, immediately.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CRAWFORD COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Purpose: The purpose of this Ordinance is to promote community involvement in maintaining the cleanliness and safety of county roads through the Adopt-A-Mile Program, encouraging volunteer participation and ensuring proper coordination and safety measures.

SECTION 2. Definitions: Adopt-A-Mile Program: A voluntary program where groups or individuals agree to periodically clean designated sections of county roads. Participant: An individual, group, or organization that has entered into an agreement with the county to adopt a highway section. Highway Section: A designated segment of county road assigned to a participant for maintenance and litter removal.

SECTION 3. Eligibility: Participation open to residents, civic groups, schools, businesses, and non-profit organizations that agree to abide by the terms of this Ordinance and any associated policies.

SECTION 4. Responsibilities of Participants: Maintain and clean the assigned highway section at least quarterly. Follow all safety guidelines, including wearing reflective vests, using safety equipment, and adhering to traffic laws. Properly dispose of collected litter in designated disposal areas. Report any hazardous conditions or damages to the County. Quarterly reports shall be provided to the County.

SECTION 5. County Responsibilities: Provide designated highway sections and necessary safety information. Supply safety equipment such as reflective vests, gloves,

and trash bags. Arrange for the pickup and disposal of collected litter. Recognize participating groups through signage or public acknowledgment.

SECTION 6. Safety and Liability: Participants shall adhere to all safety protocols established by the County and the Department of Transportation. Participants shall sign a liability waiver releasing the County from liability for injuries or damages arising from participation, except in cases of gross negligence or willful misconduct.

SECTION 7. Signage and Recognition: The County shall install signs recognizing the participating group or individual at the highway segment. Signs shall be maintained and may be removed or replaced at the County's discretion.

SECTION 8. Enforcement and Penalties: Any violation of this Ordinance or the program's guidelines may result in suspension or termination of participation. The County may pursue legal remedies for damages caused by non-compliance.

SECTION 9. Applications and quarterly reports can be found on the county website.

SECTION 10. Miscellaneous: This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption. The County reserves the right to amend or modify the program or this Ordinance as needed.
